Additional Information

1. Homer pigeons pricing is per day, not per bird. Please ensure to only utilize the **ORANGE** banded pigeons within the pigeon loft.
2. A limited quantity of quails are available for usage on training days only. Please coordinate with the training director and/or a board member for access.
3. A training pass provides unlimited access to the Ranches from March to September. It also covers training day fees on scheduled training days. There are no black out dates, however The Ranches may hold events and access may be limited during this time. If such events are to take place, The Ranches will notify in advance.
4. Hinged frame (break-open) shotguns of conventional gauge will be used. Autoloaders and pump action guns are strictly forbidden, whether loaded with blank ammunition or not. All guns will be carried in the open position until just before the shot.
5. While live ammunition is in use, all persons on the field must wear one or a combination of the following blaze orange garments: hat, vest, or jacket.
6. Loose and unattended dogs are prohibited
7. The timing and length of training sessions vary seasonally. Please be prepared for a day in the field as you might for a hunting day. Bring food, water, appropriate clothing, and any other necessities for yourself and your dog. A portable chair can be nice for watching and waiting your turn in the field.

The Ranches

We are fortunate to have the use of the excellent grounds located on the New Mexico Boys and Girls Ranch. The following rules apply with respect to the Ranch:

- Drive only to/from the gathering place for training and on the training grounds.
- An escort is required any time you are on the campus of the Ranch.
- Do not initiate interaction with the residents of the Ranch.
- While driving on the Ranch, keep your speed at or below 15 mph.
