**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN,
MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AUTHORIZING THE SALE
OF OLD ROAD SIGNS
OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, to retain ownership of old and replaced street signs; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities determine that it was in the best interests of the Village of Chapin to sell old and replaced street signs at the price of \$5.00 each.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the President and Board of Trustees find that the old and replaced street signs, now owned by the Village of Chapin, are no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by their sale.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the Village President is hereby directed to take all necessary action to sell the street signs for \$5.00 each. Any street signs not purchased may be thrown away as trash.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
