What is going to happen after Armageddon?

I. Satan will be removed - The day the Devil pays.

Revelation 20:1–3 — "1 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. ² And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; ³ and he threw him into the abyss, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time."

A. Christ will then separate the sheep from the goats - Matthew 25:31–33

- 1. Jesus spoke of this in **Matthew 25:31–33** "31 "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. ³² "All the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; ³³ and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left."
- 2. Only the righteous will be allowed to enter the kingdom:

 Matthew 25:34 "34 "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world."

- 3. The unrighteous will go to the eternal fire: Matthew 25:41
- B. Then Christ will resurrect all the tribulation Saints to enter the Kingdom.

Revelation 20:4–5 — "4 ... And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. ⁵ The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.

- 1. These include the multitude that stood on see of glass in Rev 15:2
- III. The Saints will reign for a thousand years.

Revelation 20:6 "Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years."
