Camp Procedures

Cell phones should not be used for personal reasons during camp. You can use your phone as a clock or a camera, or to contact Paige during camp, otherwise it should be put away. Do NOT post pictures of campers on social media... send them to Paige.

Three things we need to communicate to campers at ALL times:

- I am glad you are here!
- ➤ I like spending time with you!
- I like you just the way you are!

Campers should not walk around camp alone. If they are old enough, send them with a buddy. If they are younger, a staff member or volunteer should accompany them.

- Counselors should stay with their groups.... And participate in each activity.
- Station leaders should stay at their stations.
- Promote hand-sanitizing at all stations.
- ➤ Help your campers drink lots of water! Especially in the heat.
- Notify Camp Directors of any injuries, illness or conflicts between kids. Even minor ones.
- No smoking, vaping, drugs, or alcohol on camp grounds.
- > Campers should not know about your politics or relationships. We are ALL FRIENDS.
- Do not joke about campers having boyfriends or girlfriends.
- Avoid modeling dangerous behaviors... like eating fast or drinking fast.
- > Arrive by 8:00 and be present for the morning meeting.
- Do not leave until cleanup is complete and the afternoon meeting ends.
- This is a church camp. Do not swear. Dress conservatively.
- No campers on the 4-wheeler. Ever.
- Water is provided for drinking. Do not play with it.
- > Station leaders have walkie-talkies. Please limit their use to essential communication.
- Peggy is our camp nurse and is on site. Contact using the nearest walkie talkie if needed.
- Drive very slowly and safely at ALL times on camp property.
