Subject: EPINEPHRINE 1:10,000

ACTION:

Positive Chronotrope, positive Inotrope, causes bronchodilation

INDICATIONS:

Ventricular fibrillation, asystole, EMD, anaphylaxis or severe allergic reaction.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

None when used in situations listed above.

PRECAUTIONS:

Should be protected from light, can be deactivated by alkaline solutions.

SIDE EFFECTS:

Tachyarrhythmias.

DOSAGE:

Cardiac Arrest (IV): <u>1.0 mg (5 mL)</u> repeat every 3-5 min. Anaphylaxis or Severe Allergic Reaction: <u>0.3-0.5 mg (1.5-2.5 mL)</u>.

ROUTE:

IV, ET, IO, Intracardiac (not recommended)

PEDIATRIC DOSE:

<u>0.01 mg/kg</u> repeat initial IV dose only in cardiac arrest.
