### **Addressing Hazards in the Roadway**

**There** are many different types of hazards you will encounter in the roadway while riding your motorcycle. Striking objects with your motorcycle is much more dangerous and has much greater consequences than if you had struck the same object with a car, suv or pick-up truck. If you strike a pot hole, piece of truck tire, or any other substantial piece of debris with a 4-wheel vehicle the results might be a flat tire or some minor cosmetic damage. If you struck the same object with a motorcycle the result could be a crash.

**Some** types of hazards you might encounter in the roadway are as follows:

1. Wet or dry grass clippings being blown into the road during mowing.
2. Gravel kicked into the road by cars and trucks.
3. Tree branches falling from trees above the road.

4. Wet or dry leaves.
5. Dirt washed onto the road during a rain storm.
6. Deep puddles during or after a rain storm.
7. Motorcycles or other vehicles approaching from the opposite direction intruding onto your side of the road going around a curve.
8. Pieces of truck tire. (Florida Gator)
9. And many more.

**Make** sure if you have to surmount any of the potential slippery examples I have listed, you take as much lean as possible out of your bike to reduce the chance of sliding out and losing control. No braking, down shifting or abrupt throttle deceleration while crossing over these areas.

**The** best way to avoid any hazard is not to encounter it in the first place. To be able to avoid a hazard you must see it soon enough and far enough away so you have enough time and space to avoid it. Braking or swerving only works if you have enough time and distance to execute these maneuvers. A person needs at least two seconds to react. It takes about one second for your eyes to tell your brain something needs to be done. It takes about another second for your hands and feet to begin to move to accomplish whatever action is required. Much literature has now been changed to three seconds being the minimum amount of reaction

time required. More is better. The proper reaction time distance directly related to the proper following distance. If you are closer than 2-3 seconds behind the vehicle in front of you, you will not have enough time and distance to react should some hazard appear.

**Riding** at night reduces your reaction time even if there is not a vehicle in front of you. There is a line between where your headlight is lighting the road and the darkness just beyond your headlight beam. The distance of this line depends on your speed and headlight adjustment. This line should also always be 2-3 seconds ahead of you. If that distance is shorter than 2-3 seconds slow down accordingly.

**A** legally, properly adjusted headlight is supposed to be 150 ft. on low beam and 450 ft. on high beam. At 50 mph the distance of two second ahead you is already 150 ft. If you are going faster, such as 70 mph on the interstate, you are already over riding your low beam headlight distance. You can switch to high beam for additional distance. But, remember if you are running with your high beam on and another vehicle is approaching you from the opposite direction; legally you must switch back to low beam. At that point you are now drastically over riding your headlight distance.

### **Motorcycle hits, kills man standing in road at previous motorcycle crash: FHP.**

**The** headline above is tragic. One of the 10 safety presentations available for DOWNLOAD AFTER MEMBER LOGIN at the EWMA Safety Presentations website is "3 First on the Scene Response" which contains information that may prevent such tragedies.

**Topics** addressed in "3 First on the Scene Response" are:

- Planning & Preparation for motorcycle crashes
- How to secure and control the Crash Scene
- How to provide rapid and appropriate emergency medical services response
- How to deal with the aftermath

**Of** importance with respect to the headline above, How to secure and control the Crash Scene is summarized here.

**Someone** (preferably only one) has to take charge and assign tasks! For group rides, this person should have been identified in the ride pre-brief. The group tail gunner is the first choice recommended by EWMA. Some alpha males may need to step aside and take directions! **GIVE YOUR BEST EFFORT TO WHATEVER TASK YOU MAY BE ASSIGNED!** Scene Coordinator, Traffic Control, First Aid, Communications, Crowd Control, etc.

**Stay** Visible Yourself: Ensure that you and any other individuals involved in securing the area are also highly visible to passing motorists. Wear reflective clothing or vests and position yourself in a well-lit area away from oncoming traffic to minimize the risk of further accidents or injuries.

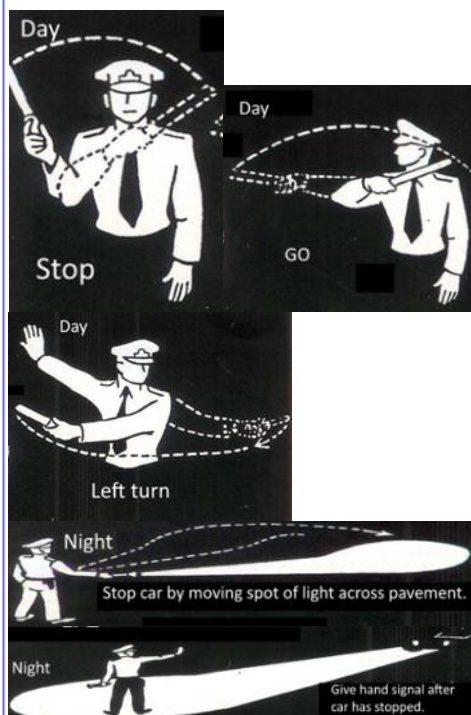
**The** objective of these initial steps is to prevent further physical injury and property damage by re-routing passing traffic around the accident scene. Use anything available as a visual "heads up" and/or physical barrier to the danger ahead for approaching traffic: reflective clothing, emergency flashers on all bikes (the more the merrier), flares, flashlights, traffic triangles, traffic cones, helmets, jackets, other bikes, etc. **DO NOT USE YOUR BODY AS AN OBSTACLE!**

**Hopefully** you have gotten the attention of approaching vehicles, now you must direct them safely around/away from the accident site. To be honest, the standard hand and light signals depicted in the presentation to route traffic around an accident scene are inadequate in my view. While there are standard hand signals to control traffic, you probably won't remember them in a crisis. Nevertheless, here are the day/night hand and flashlight signal graphics from the presentation.

### **POW/MIA Recognition Day** 19 September 2025

**You** Are Not Forgotten -- that's the central phrase behind the POW/MIA remembrance movement that honors America's prisoners of war, those who are still missing in action and their families.

**Many** of our service members suffered as prisoners of war

during several decades of varying conflicts. While some of them made it home, tens of thousands more never did.

**POW/MIA** Recognition Day is commemorated on the third Friday of every September, a date that's not associated with any particular war. In 1979, Congress and the president passed resolutions making it official after the families of the more than 2,500 Vietnam War POW/MIAs pushed for full accountability.

**During** the first POW/MIA Recognition Day commemoration, a ceremony was held at the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C., while the 1st Tactical Squadron from Langley Air Force Base in Virginia flew the missing man formation. Most ceremonies

since then have been held at the Pentagon, and many smaller observances have cropped up across the nation and around the world on military installations.

**The** point of POW/MIA Recognition Day is to ensure that American remembers to stand behind those who serve and to make sure we do everything we can to account for those who have never returned.

### **The POW/MIA Flag**

**For** every POW/MIA Recognition Day since 1982, the flag has flown just below the stars and stripes at the White House – the only other flag to ever do so. In 1998, Congress ordered it to also be displayed on Armed Forces Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day and Veterans Day.

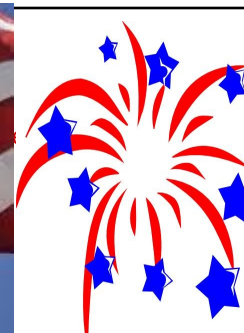
