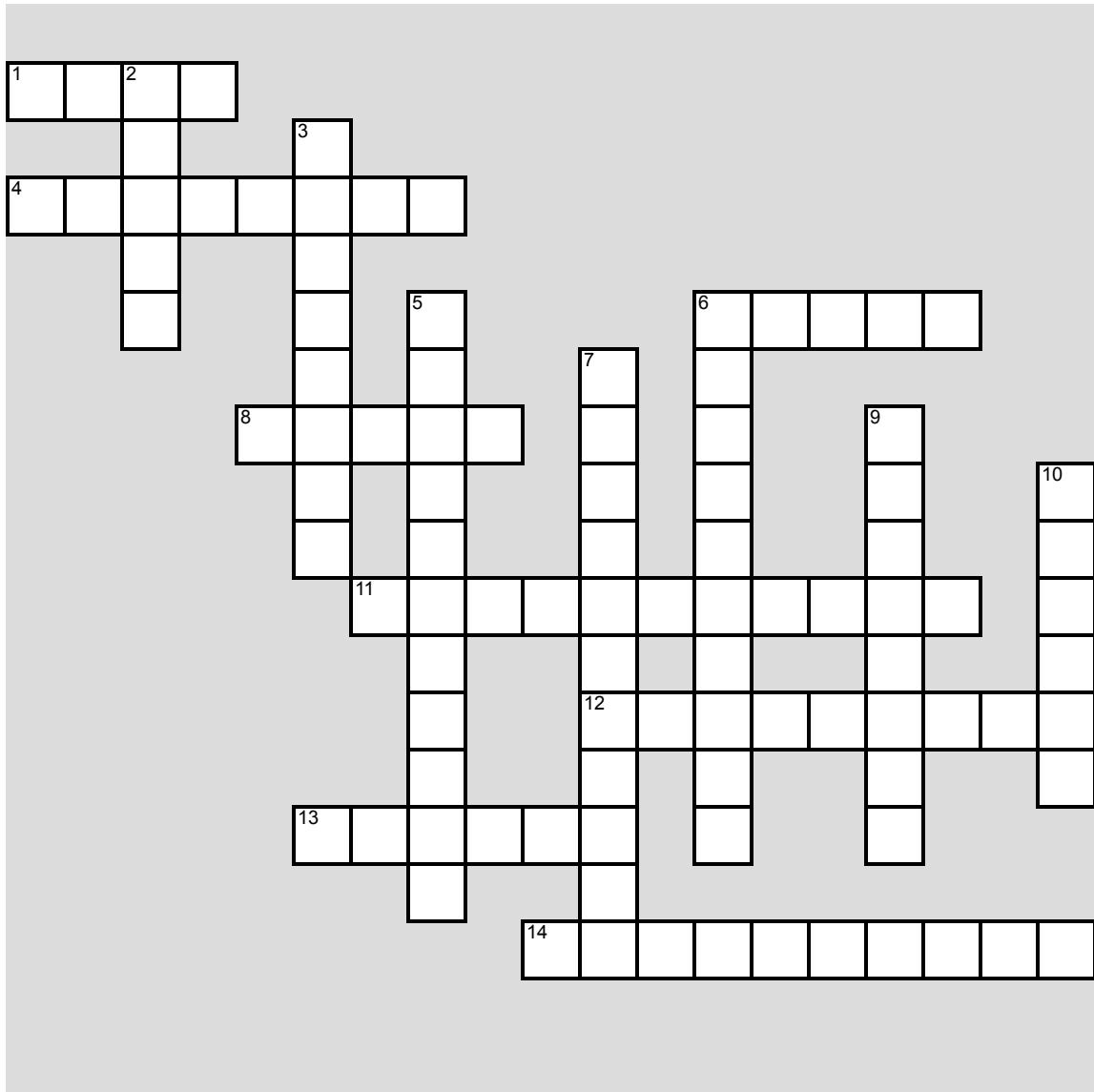


Our "Towns"

- 1** The nation's first cheese factory was started in this city
- 4** President Grover Cleveland briefly lived here.
- 6** This town is named after signer of the Declaration of Independence Major General William _____.
- 8** This town shares its name with the famous French city, but is named for farmer Issac _____, who helped feed the town during the 1789 famine.
- 11** Settled in 1788 by Jedediah Sanger on land purchased from George Washington and George Clinton
- 12** The Holland Land Company sent Gerritt Boon to settle this area in 1795
- 13** Located on the western border of the county, this town was once called Orange and Bengal before acquiring its current name in 1816.
- 14** This town was created before Oneida County was established.

- 2** The NYS Thruway was built through here in 1955.
- 3** Named in honor of the first Chief Justice of the US Supreme Court
- 5** Home to one of NY State's First African American Mayors, Everett Holmes
- 6** Oneida County's most northern town
- 7** This village was once called "The Coney Island of Central New York"
- 9** The smallest city in Oneida County
- 10** Welsh settlers helped populate this town in the late 1700s and early 1800s
