Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed Courthouse Staff and Elected Officials as they joined us for the opening prayer led by Kyle Carroll. The pledge was then said by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the agenda as presented. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second. All in favor. Motion approved. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White gave an update on the 911 building located at road & bridge. He advised the building is almost complete with a few minor touchups as well as waiting on the generator.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek discussed ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) and The Wayfair Bill with the Commission. Melissa will update the Commission as more information becomes available concerning ARPA.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman and Chief Deputy Tracy Neill met with the Commission to discuss equipment and that the radios were in. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen thanked Sheriff Keesaman for letting him “ride along” this past week. Chet felt it was very informative and appreciated the ability to do this. Sheriff Keesaman voiced a concern with the door that goes into the holding room for prisoners. The Commission will have Colhour Welding look at it and see what needs to be done to make it more secure.

The Commission received a patron concern regarding width on gravel roads. It was also noted that road signs on gravel roads are not the responsibility of the County. The 911 signs are the only responsibility of the County.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek reminded everyone that she has set up a Township Meeting for May 11th to be held at the June Conley Building at 6 p.m. Attorney Ivan Schraeder will be the guest speaker and the meeting will only be for Township Board Members, their Clerk, and Trustee/Treasurer.

Prosecuting Attorney, Erik Tate is moving back upstairs where the Prosecutor’s Office originally was along with the Victim’s Advocate. At this time Probation and Parole will have their offices elsewhere in the building until a new office is ready for them.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White gave an update on the new 911 tower building. Once the generator and a/c is installed it will be completed.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.
