Population Served

BATGO, Inc. strives to place youths in Treatment Foster Homes best suited to their personal, social, and psychological needs. BATGO, Inc.'s comprehensive program provides highly trained and dedicated staff and Treatment Foster Parents. Our Treatment Foster Parents provide daily supervision and structure to each youth by appropriate role modeling.

Objectives

BATGO, Inc. objectives are:

- To provide unconditional care to the youth placed in our foster homes.
- To assist youth in developing coping strategies to decrease the instances of angry outburst.
- To assist in building self-esteem and feelings of self worth in our youths.
- To assist older youths in developing life skills necessary to becoming self-sufficient.
- To assist youth in developing positive/healthy peer and adult relationships.
- To decrease the incidence of truancy.
- To decrease the incidence of AWOL behavior.
