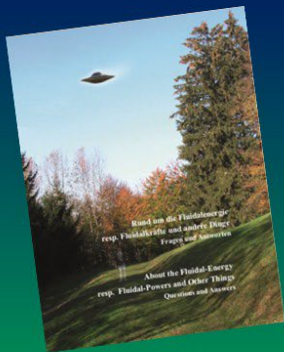


FLCA Annual Report 2025

2024 can be regarded as a year of tragedy, abundance, surprise and progress. As you are well aware of, if you attended last year's meeting, we reported that on Feb. 6, 2024, Jimmy Chen, a founding member of the FLCA, tragically died in a single car accident at the age of 39. This unexpected occurrence left us scrambling to resolve many outstanding responsibilities that needed to be dealt with. Jimmy had been very active in supporting our organisation through his many efforts which included his function as treasurer, main translator and formatter of several of our books which we subsequently published such as *About the Fluidal Energy, Rebirth, Life, Dying, Death and Sorrow, Arahata Athersata*, etc. and he was also a creator of various presentations on the Creation-energy teaching. He had been currently working on *Genesis* but due to unforeseen circumstances, most of his publishing files were lost. This forced us to adjust and adapt to the new reality which has been very challenging and fraught with growing pangs.

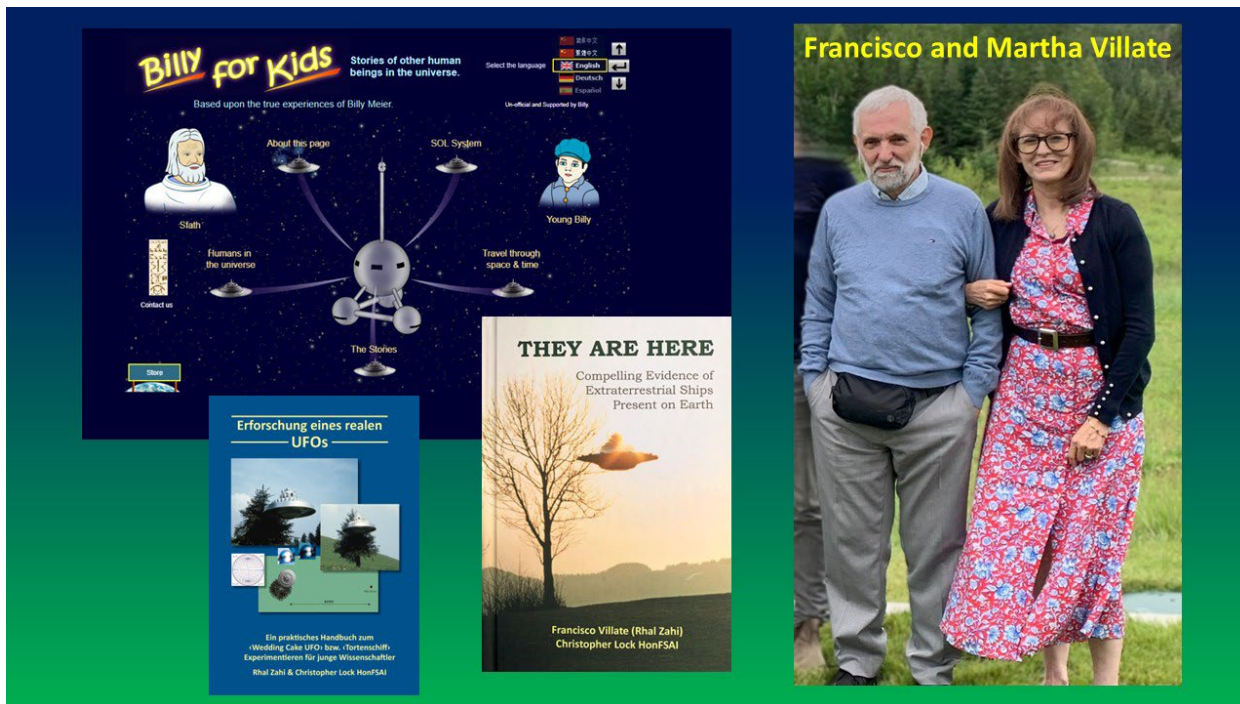

As you will see later in this presentation, Lyndon Kroker volunteered to take on the daunting task of treasurer, to which he has made many new improvements. Additionally, 3 members have taken on the task of book formatting and the subsequent proper storage of files, so that in the future, publishing will no longer be a problem.



Where there is loss there is also gain, and to that end we are pleased to announce that we now have 3 new members: Tyler Rutland, Francisco Villate and Martha Villate, each with substantial skills, knowledge and experience that will help propel FLCA to new levels. Tyler, the youngest member, has talents with his social media savvy, design and book formatting,



while Francisco, aka Zahl Rahi, with whom you may be familiar with, has published several books and videos investigating the veracity of the wedding cake ship photographs and other beamship materials. He is also the publisher of the 'Billy for Kids' website. Both Francisco and Martha, due to their Spanish speaking background, offer a unique connection to that community.



We are currently preparing to publish the German/English edition of Genesis, which was delayed by over 1 year due to the new translation proofing requirements and the implementation of the correct terminology to replace Geist and all of its grammatical derivatives. Subsequently it was also necessary to reformat the book from scratch. Our group opted to utilise the open-source publishing platform called Scribus which is available across all platforms including Mac, Windows and Linux.

Regarding our public meetings, we continue to host these once per month on Zoom for those persons interested in FIGU who live in Canada. On average we have approximately 25 attendees. Christian Frehner was present on a couple of occasions where together we had open discussions on various FIGU topics. It must be noted that throughout the year several participants have consistently volunteered to share their experiences, talks and presentations pertaining to the Creation-energy teaching. Both Paul Saleh and Daniel Cooper have made substantial contributions in this area.

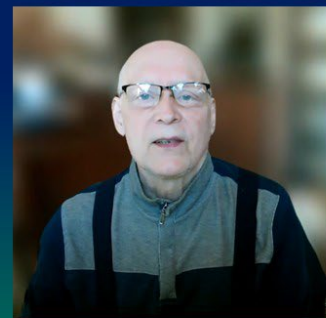

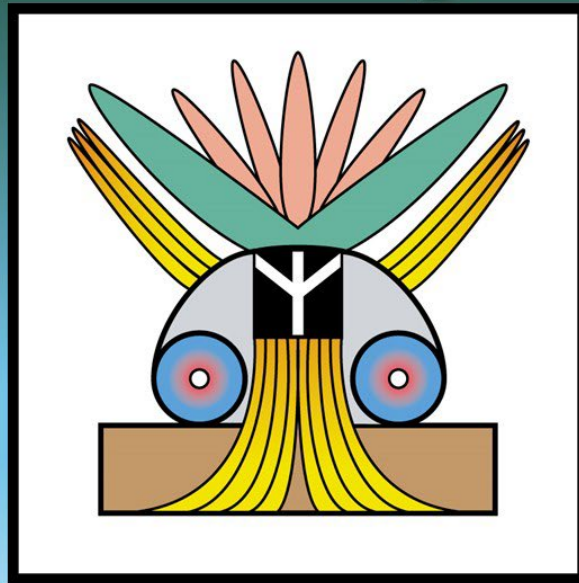

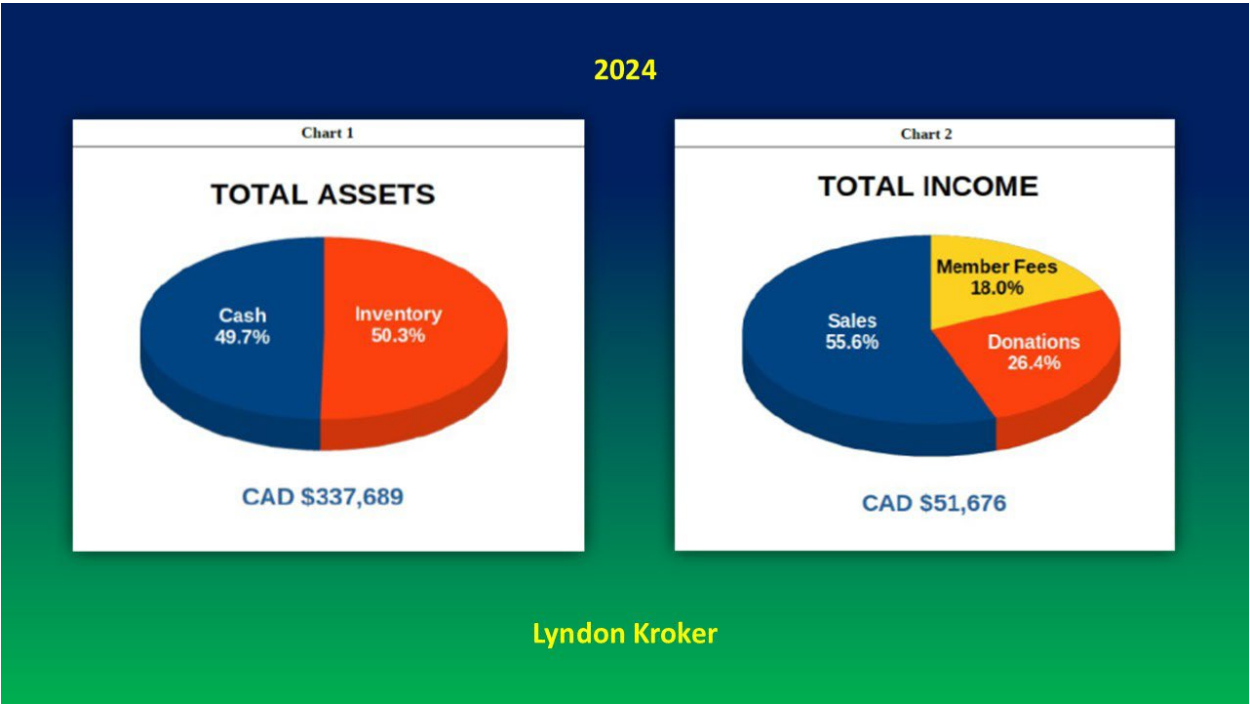

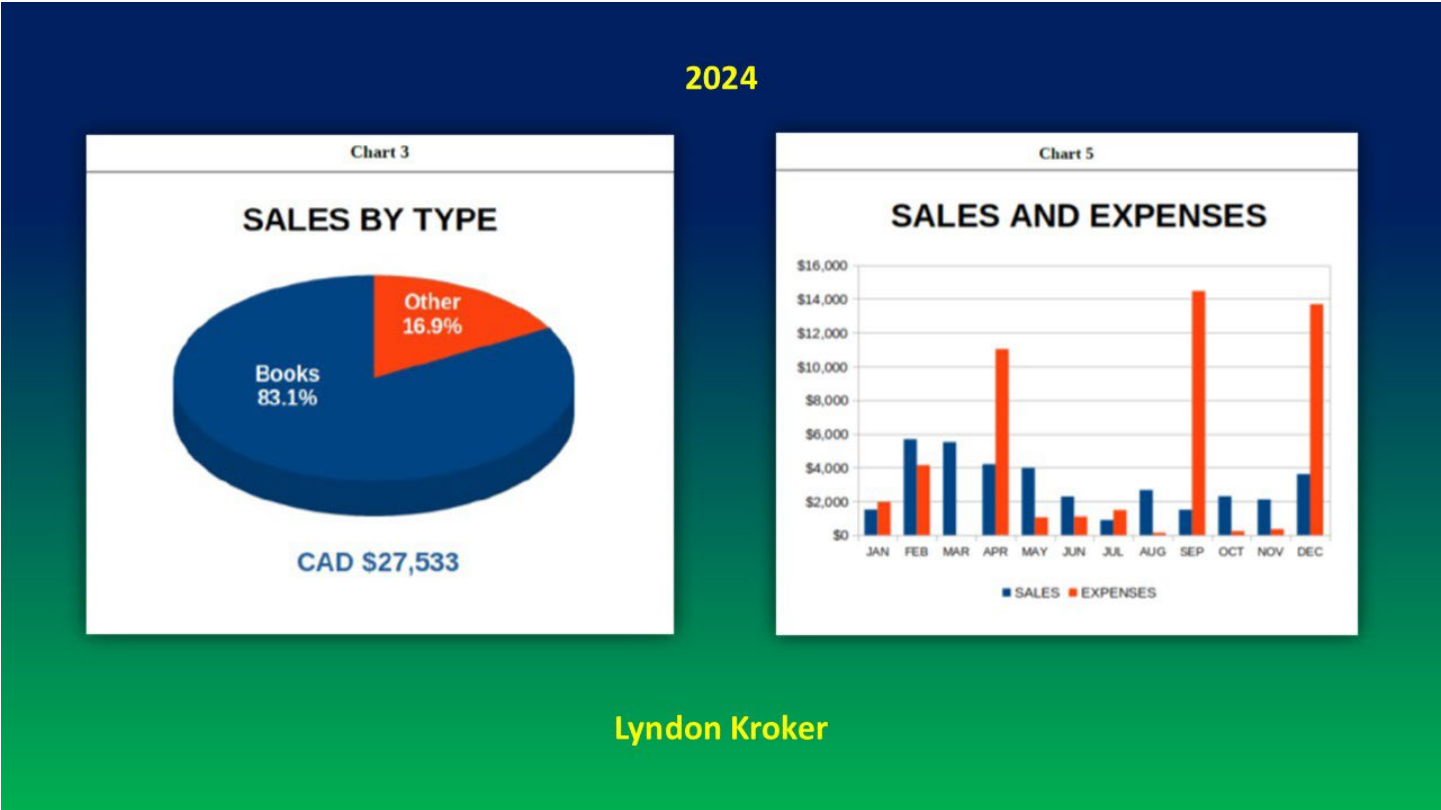

The red bars in the sales and expenses graph represent our expenses which are predominantly comprised of book publishing and shipping.
