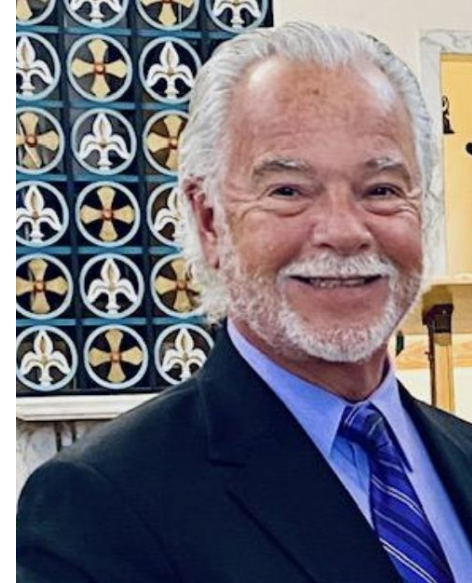

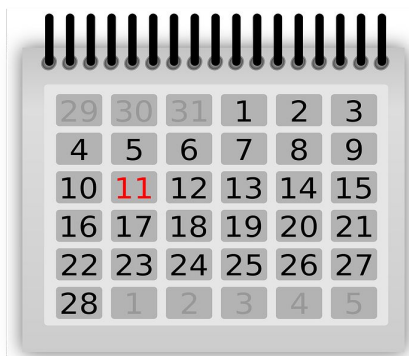

Hello there! My name is Emily Meyer. I am 20 years old, a junior in college and the founder of the Emily Meyer Foundation. I wanted to tell you about a toy drive I started fifteen years ago:

On Christmas night in 2009, I became very sick and was admitted to Good Samaritan Hospital.

The next day, a Child Life Representative greeted me with a large gift bag filled with toys.

My mom thanked her but said that I already received Christmas presents. The Child Life team explained that no child should be in the hospital during the holiday season but if they are, they should feel the joy of the holidays while they are there. 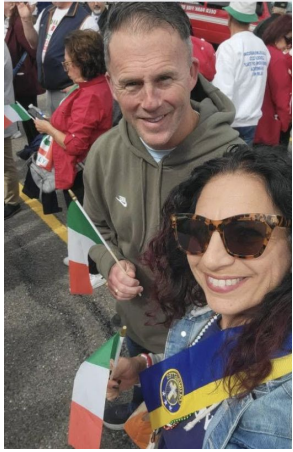

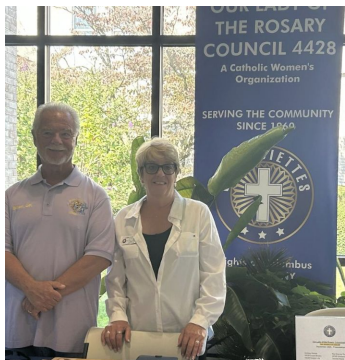
