



BARN RULES

The Following Rules and Regulations of Hill Crest Farm LLC are issued to all boarders, riders, families and their guests. These Rules and Regulations are published for the purpose of maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for all horses, boarders, riders, and their guests. Violations of these rules may result in termination of the boarding/training/lesson agreement.

Barn Hours:

Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day: Closed

Summer Hours: Monday thru Sunday: 8:00 am until 9:00 pm

Winter Hours: Monday thru Friday: 8:00 am to 8:00 pm and Saturday Sunday: 8:00 am until 7:00 pm

Barn:

Please help us keep the barn, viewing rooms, tack room and indoor clean, tidy and safe by following these rules:

- Clean up after yourself-including picking up manure from the aisles, crossties, wash rack, indoor after riding and put tack and supplies away (brooms, pitch forks etc.)
- Horses may not be left unattended on the crossties, other than to walk into the tack room for equipment or supplies
- Please turn off all lights when finished and close all doors and lock all gates.
- Our personnel cleans each stall twice daily, boarders are not permitted to pick a stall themselves and self-service of shavings is not permitted
- Tack may be stored in the designated tack room on designated bridle and saddle hooks(Hill Crest Farm is not responsible for damaged, lost, stolen or moldy tack)
- No unauthorized borrowing of tack or supplies owned by clear round or other boarders
- Hang up hoses at the wash rack and make sure the water is turned off when finished

Facilities and General Care:

The following rules apply to the grounds and facilities at Hill Crest Farm:

- Grazing is not permitted in barn owners front/back yard
- No outside dogs allowed on property
- DO NOT pet owners dogs or approach them in their yard!!
- Please do not walk thru owners front/back yard
- Please help us keep the porta potty restroom clean
- Please put recycling in recycling can and garbage in trash can
- Please close and lock all gates and doors.

Feed and Supplements:

Hill Crest Farm uses only premium feeds and hay, and works closely with clients to customize each horse's diet based on exercise and conditioning. The following rules help us ensure that each horse receives the nutrition required to perform at their best.

- Horses are fed grain by barn personnel two times per day and hay four times a day, boarders are not permitted to feed horses themselves and self-service of feed and hay is not allowed
- Additional feed and/or supplements will be given by barn personnel and stored in the designated feed room. We prefer that your supplements are in Smartpacks

Riding and Training:

We maintain excellent facilities for riding and training our horses-with premium footing in our indoor and outdoor arenas. The following rules help us ensure a safe environment for both horse and rider:

- Hill Crest Farm **Encourages** all riders to wear helmets and requires all riders under the age of 21 to wear approved safety helmets at all times when mounted
 - While working with your horse please be respectful of other riders, lessons/and or training sessions. Lesson riders have right of way.
- To help us maintain our schedule, please be prompt for all lessons- we will not be able to extend your lesson time if you are late
- If you need to turn the arena lights on, please turn them off when you are finished if no one else needs them
- Please do not move Jumps, Cavelettis, or Poles
- Jumping is only permitted with trainer supervision
- Guests may not ride without prior consent of Hill Crest farm staff, a release must be signed
- No shorts, tank tops, or sandals allowed when riding. Proper attire is paddock boots, tall boots, helmet, jeans or breeches, collared shirt, and/or chaps.
- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your lesson time to groom and tack your horse
- All injuries, accidents and damage must be immediately brought to management's attention. Accident report forms are located in viewing room.

IN CASE OF FIRE: Call 911!! Evacuate all horses to the outer pastures if possible. Fire Extinguishers will be located at either end of the barn. Call 911!
