Aloha Kakou,

We have been using Setting Ten in worship for many months now. We will use it one last time on All Saints' Sunday, November 3rd, before switching to Setting Four. That is the setting in which we chant the Kyrie responsively and sing "This is the Feast." This setting is more contemplative than the others and that is appropriate for Advent.

Speaking of Advent, several of you have asked, and, yes, we will once again be extending it out from four weeks to seven weeks. This extension puts Advent on a par with Lent, which has five Sundays plus Palm Sunday. It also just gives us more time to contemplate the arrival of Jesus into our lives, as he is not "out there" somewhere, but "in, with, under, and around us" here and now.

Finally, an extended Advent allows us to focus on the true meaning of the season, and in doing so, challenging the crass commercialization of Christmas.

I do not need to tell you that already stores have huge holiday displays up and running. I have a meme somewhere that if I find it, I will probably repost. It says, "The anxiety you feel will not be soothed by buying more stuff."

So as we head toward All Saints' Sunday and Advent, I invite you to join me in considering the Reason for the Season.

Welcome to those of you who come bearing diverse gifts including wisdom regarding sexual orientations, gender identities and gender expressions.




Welcome to all of you for your diverse colors, shapes, cultures, backgrounds, and traditions.
