

7th Executed a building permit for Nick Harrington, map 5, lot 3-A, along state route #113, a 9 acre plot located on Sanborn Pond. Harrington determined that the existing shed was beyond repair and intends to construct a small and new structure with a 100 foot setback from water. The first phase will be an initial 16' x 20' space to quickly establish a living space of about 320 sq. ft. However, within the 2 year time line of permit completion, more additions shall be constructed to bring the space to at least the 600 sq. ft. requirement.

9th Patco LLC requested an inspection of the expanded additions to the storage structures and grounds soon to be opened for business. These manufactured metal sheds on two slabs are fully erected with gravel driveway access graded in place. A chain link fence has been erected totally around the perimeter of the storage shed area following about a 3 foot inset of the property line. A rolling gate shall be installed. Lighting along the fronts of these sheds are directed towards the ground. A sign is fastened to the fencing at the road front and is of acceptable size. Security cameras are yet to be installed. Plans are to plant grass and shrubs in non-surfaced areas. A "buffer" of trees is planned at the fence next to #17 School Street that will enhance the area.
