General

LODORE WWF-2 Wireless Water Filler keeps your pool topped up easily and automatically. This product senses water level and fill the pool wirelessly and automatically when water level is low.

This product functions wirelessly, so no hose or water pipes are exposed on the ground around your pool. It looks clean and neat from above the pool.

For a pool to function optimally, water levels must be maintained. Evaporation from the sun and wind and even rambunctious pool use will have an impact. If water level drops below the skimmer, the pump can run dry and damage or even burn out the motor. This product maintains pre-set water levels automatically and eliminates the need to keep an eye on the water level.

LODORE WWF-2 Wireless Water Filler fits in any type of existing Pool and Spa.

Installation

1. Fixing the controller unit on the wall of pool equipment room toward the pool by screwing the unit on the wall (See Figure A). The distance between the controller unit and the sensor shall not exceed 15 meters and avoid any huge barriers such as walls or concrete structure in between. Plug the Transformer into the controller unit Port 1 (See Figure B) .
2. Connect two cables of Valve to the Controller unit Port2 (See Figure B).
3. Connect the output of the Valve with water line of the pool through a PVC Tee; Connect the input of the Valve with the house outdoor faucet through garden hose and check for leaks. (See Figure C)
4. Install the Sensor unit to the pool by screwing the holder on the pool edge so that the Sensor unit submerged into water (See Figure D). MAKE SURE THE THREAD CAP END OUT OF WATER AND THE SENSOR END INTO THE WATER, DO NOT INSTALL IT REVERSELY. Adjust the Sensor to the desired level by simply (gently) moving it up and down. Normally the sensor is at $\frac{1}{2}$ of the skimmer.
5. Twisting off the thread cap to check or change battery. The battery should be changed annually under normal use.

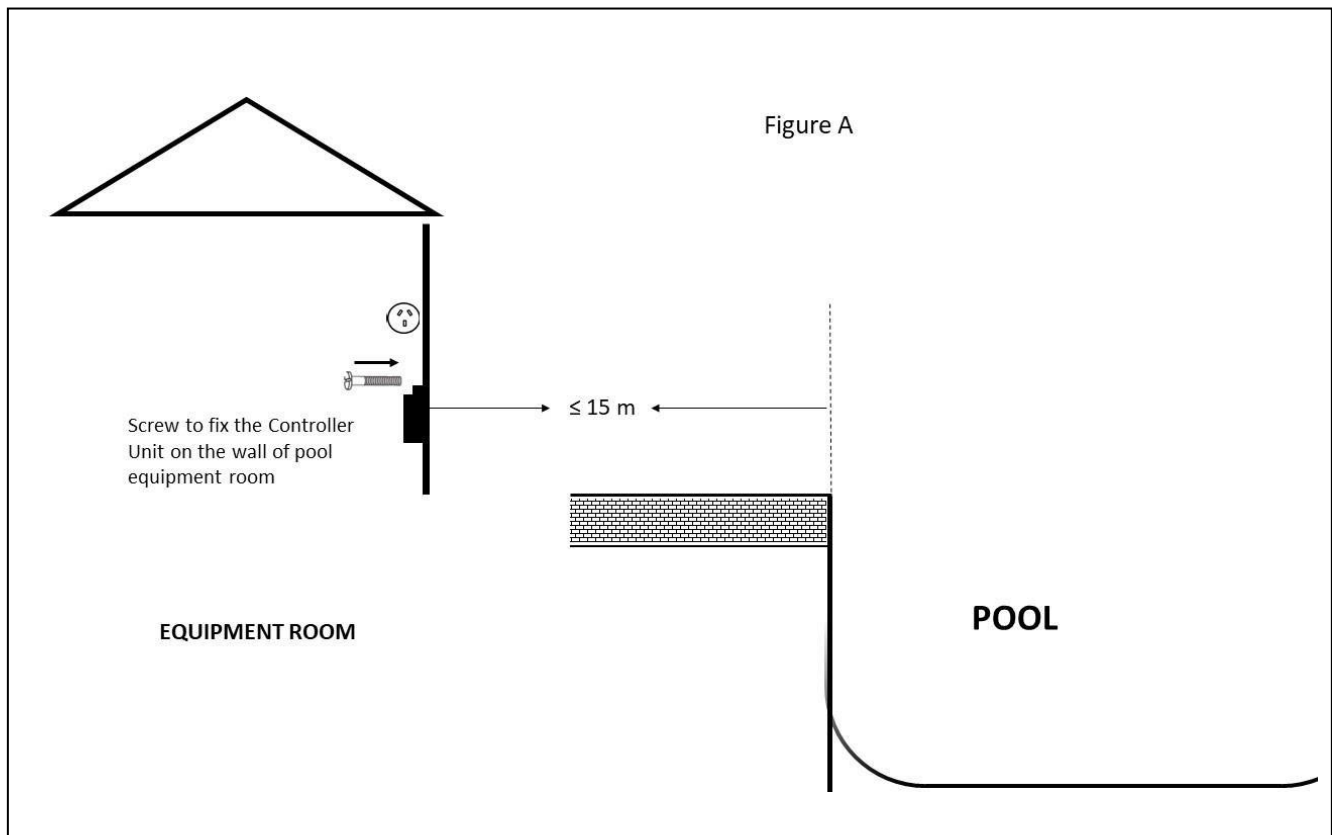

Maintenance

Inspect the Sensor Unit to ensure that the battery is changed annually.

Generally this product does not need service, however, check the place of the Sensor Unit regularly to make sure its position is recommended.

Always be careful and pay attention when using the equipment to avoid over strain of the Sensor Unit.
