POLICY FOR DAY TRIPS

As you know, we always try and resell your ticket so that you don't lose any money. We understand that things happen that we cannot foresee and we try our best to get someone to replace your reservation so that no one is out the money. Unfortunately, this is becoming more and more of an issue and is putting us in a difficult spot. Please contact us on a one to one basis if you have financial difficulties with this policy and we will do our best to work with you.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel Insurance for Overnight trips - Travel insurance is available for you to purchase at time of reservation. If you would like to purchase Travel Insurance you need to go on our website at www.newbeginningtour.com and on the home page, click the Travel Guard Insurance Tab and follow the directions. You are able to pick and choose the different types of insurance you would like. If you have a pre-existing condition, you will need to get your insurance 14 days from making your initial deposit. This goes for all overnight and multi day trips. (not including Collette and Cruises) For your information, listed below are cancellation penalties that will take place without insurance. Deposit becomes non-refundable at 60 days prior to departure date. 60-46 days prior to departure, there is a cancellation fee of 50% of total price, 45-31- days prior to departure, there is a cancellation fee of 75% of total price & 30-0 - days of departure there is a cancellation fee of 100% of total price.






