HOLY SPIRIT COME LIKE A FIRE

Hello Church Family,

In our journey of faith, there are pivotal moments when we are reminded of the profound presence and guidance of the Holy Spirit. One such moment is the Rite of Confirmation. It is a special occasion in which our youth affirm their baptism and participation in the work of Christ. Through this sacrament, they are empowered to embrace their faith journey with newfound strength and conviction.

The Rite of Confirmation represents a crossroads moment. It is a ritual where we are meant to step out of our immature faith and into a mature faith. The Confirmation graduates become full members of the church and are to be treated as brothers and sisters in Christ. But when we enter a mature faith, who is there to guide us? As believers, we understand the Holy Spirit to be the divine advocate, counselor, and comforter sent by God to dwell within us. In Acts Chapter 2, the Holy Spirit descends on the disciples like a fire.

"When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them." Acts 2:1-4

In a few weeks we will celebrate Pentecost Sunday, and remember that with the Holy Spirit to empower them, people of faith came together to preach the good news, serve one another, share in the Lord's Supper and baptize others into the faith of Christ.

Reflecting on our own baptisms, we are reminded of the transformative power of the Holy Spirit. Baptism is more than a ritual; for us it is a sacrament. A sacred remembrance of the work of Jesus, symbolizing our cleansing from sin and our emergence into new life in Christ. When we baptism children, it is our prayer that they will someday find that forgiveness of sin and new life in Christ. How do we get there? It is the Holy Spirit who initiates and sustains this process of spiritual renewal within us.

Similarly, on Confirmation Sunday we will ask our students to participate in the sacrament of communion, we encounter the presence of Christ through the elements of bread and wine. As we partake in this sacred meal, it is the Holy Spirit who draws us into communion with God and with one another, binding us together as the body of Christ.

In times of uncertainty or spiritual need, we can take comfort in the assurance that the Holy Spirit is ever-present, guiding us along the path of discipleship. Through prayer, reflection on Scripture, and participation in the sacramental life of the church, we open ourselves to the transforming work of the Spirit in our lives.

May we continually seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we navigate the joys and challenges of our faith journey together.






