First Lesson **Jeremiah 23:5-6** [5](#) "Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.[6](#) In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'

Second Lesson **1 Corinthians 3:5-13** [5](#) What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. [6](#) I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth.[7](#) So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. [8](#) He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor.[9](#) For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building.[10](#) According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it.[11](#) For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.[12](#) Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw--[13](#) each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done.

Gospel **John 16:25-33** [25](#) "I have said these things to you in figures of speech. The hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figures of speech but will tell you plainly about the Father.[26](#) In that day you will ask in my name, and I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf;[27](#) for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.[28](#) I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I am leaving the world and going to the Father."[29](#) His disciples said, "Ah, now you are speaking plainly and not using figurative speech![30](#) Now we know that you know all things and do not need anyone to question you; this is why we believe that you came from God."[31](#) Jesus answered them, "Do you now believe?[32](#) Behold, the hour is coming, indeed it has come, when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and will leave me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with me.[33](#) I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

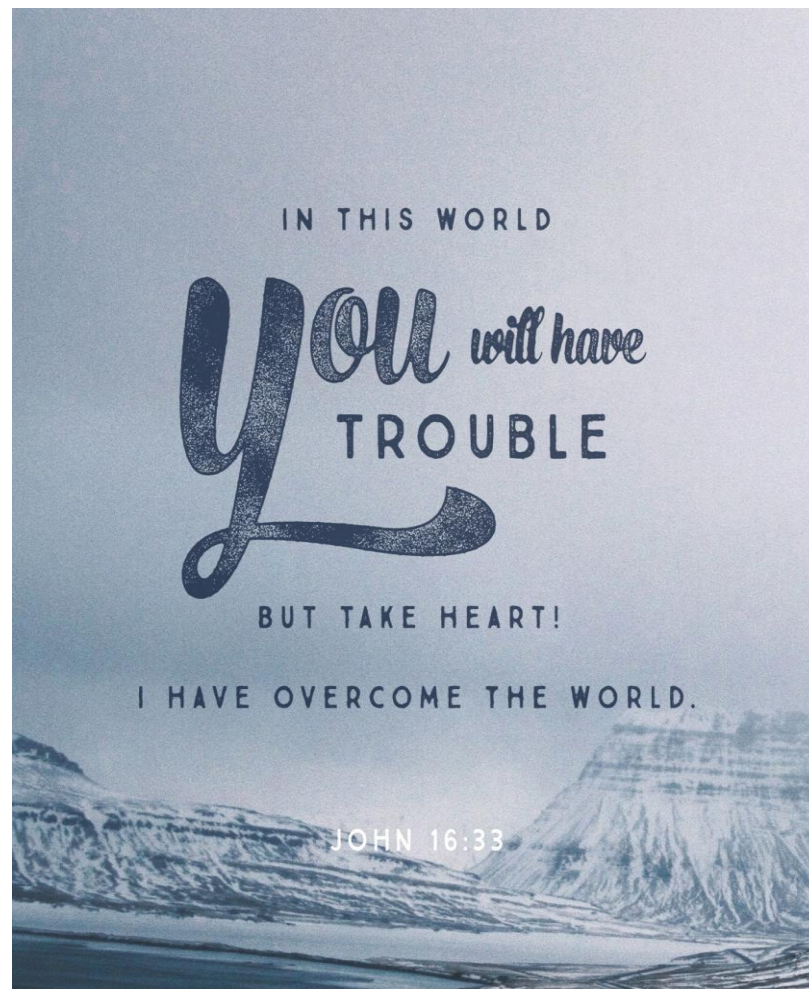
