Fred Zalewski

1939-2018

Fredrick D. Zalewski was born in Wausau, WI. He was a military veteran, and an avid hunter, fisherman, gun collector and story-teller. His early career in drag racing earned Fred induction into the Union Grove Dragway Hall of Fame.

Owner of Eagle Trading Company, the gun store located on N. Sheridan Rd., Fred was instrumental in defeating an attempt to ban handguns in the city of Kenosha during the 1994 elections. He donated use of his shop to serve as campaign headquarters for Southport Gun Club's PAC, "Kenosha Citizens Against Crime."

Fred passed away on Dec. 18th at Kenosha Hospital surrounded by his family. He was preceded in death by a son, Jeffrey and is survived by his wife Shirley and daughters Jacqueline and Yvonne.

The club sent a "Patriot" flower arrangement to Fred's family to express our condolences.

Security Cameras To The Rescue

The recently installed camera system came in handy on TWO occasions in November.

First, a member left behind (on a chair in the meeting room) their gun case with pistol, etc. Narrowing down the time, the video recorder then revealed the owner.

Similarly, one of the league shooters left a stack of pistol targets in the range. They were found later by another league member who moved them into the office. New targets were issued to the first shooter and the originals were returned to stock.


2nd NOTICE 2019 TO ALL SOUTHPORT MEMBERS: NRA Membership is Required to Maintain Southport Membership

According to the club's bylaws, all members must also be NRA members. All new members must provide their NRA number prior to acceptance into the club. To maintain our status as an NRA Gold Medal Club, we must also insure that club members remain NRA members. Therefore, except for NRA Life Members, we must all validate NRA membership in January of each year.

Methods of Compliance:

Submit or photo copy the mailing label from your current NRA Magazine. Mail it to Stephen Close, 639 Ivy Court, Kenilworth, IL 60043, or e-mail to stephen.close@sbcglobal.net or bring it to the January club meeting.

The electronic access key for any member who does not comply by the end of February will be disabled. Subsequently, after validation, keys will be turned back on at the next regular meeting. Dues will not be recoverable for the time an individual key is shut down.



Range Courtesy (OFFICE THERMOSTAT USAGE)

The range and office areas have separate heating systems. We must keep the doors between them closed! To minimize lead exposure and maximize heating efficiency, **NEVER SWITCH THE THERMOSTAT TO THE "HOLD" FUNCTION AND NEVER ADJUST THE SET-BACK PROGRAMMING.** Use only the UP and DOWN buttons as needed. If you forget to turn the heat back down the thermostat is programmed to automatically set back every six hours.

Mid-range Target Placement for Safety

Because the ballistic steel in the bullet trap is comprised of 10 separate plates, there are gaps between them. The top of these plates are located about 10 inches below the top of the trap, thus creating another sharp edge. To protect the trap and minimize bullet splatter, it is imperative that all shots are carefully aimed at a target that is placed on the target holders. **TO AVOID INJURY FROM BULLET SPLATTER, ALL SHOOTING MUST BE DONE FROM BEHIND THE YELLOW LINE!**

If a mid-range target holder is used, it must be positioned so that the target is located directly between the individual shooter's eye and the center of a ballistic steel plate. As shown in the photo at the right, the target must be posted exactly centered under one of the lane numbers that are just above the trap. It must also be located at the same visual height (or lower) than the target holders either side of the adjacent lanes.
