



NOTES FROM KATHY SMITHSON DEMO

Our guest speaker Kathy Smithson. is an excellent, prize winning pastel and colored pencil artist. Especially notable for her animal and bird paintings. She does online sales of originals, prints and commissions At our meeting, she did a pastel demonstration of a handsome monkey portrait. Kathryn is very detailed in her work. She worked from an iPad for her reference photo. She pulls some of her reference photos from free online websites, Pixels and Pixabay. Kathryn uses a transfer to place the initial image on 400 grit sanded paper. She used a variety of hard and soft pastels and pastel pencils. Pastel pencil brands she likes are Derwent, Faber-Castel Pitt and Stabilo Carbothello.

Kathryn does her own framing using double mats and spacers. We all enjoyed learning insights into how she works and new tips on pastel painting. Thanks for a great presentation Kathryn (aka; grandma)!
