Artist Sales: 100% of your sales go to you! We do not take a percentage of sales. Booth Fees help pay for Festival advertising, marketing, and promotion—which brings more qualified buyers to YOU.

Location, Artist Space & Electricity: Esther Short Park, in Vancouver, WA. A Single Space is 10 ft X 10 ft, and a Double Space is 10 ft X 20 ft. Electricity and 3 Exhibitor Passes per day are included.

Jurying of Art: If you are a FIRST-TIME participant, you are required to submit samples to our Jury. The Festival does not accept imports. Returning artists are exempt from jury. (See application for details)

Booth Fees: The Booth Fee is \$250 for a Single Booth, \$550 for a Double Booth. Electrical Fee is \$50. Electricity is required for all Artists and Crafters.

Your booth fees provide:

 3-Day Artist Space, 3 Exhibitor Passes per day, Electricity, Link to your website, and the added value of our Festival advertising, social media, e-blasts, and more. Sell your art, and enjoy the great jazz, blues, art, wine, food – and FUN – at the 2022 Festival!
