Ossa Wilson, age 89, of Elkton, died Saturday morning, June 22 at Provincial House, Cass City. She was born Nov. 14, 1895 in Argyle, daughter of the late Daniel and Rachel (Webster) Morell.

On Dec. 17, 1913 she was united in marriage to Obed Wilson in Elkton. He preceded her in death July 24, 1963. Mrs. Wilson lived in Huron County most of her life and was a member of the Chandler Presbyterian Church and Women's Association, the Elkton Senior Citizens and a past member of the Blue Star Mothers.
