

ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 4

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 97-6 ENTITLED
“AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HIRING STANDARDS FOR FULL-TIME AND
PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN,
MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 97-6 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:

The total number of hours a part-time police officer can work in a calendar year may not exceed the maximum number of hours permitted by the laws and regulations of the State of Illinois.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
