



KITTITAS COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT #7

- **COVERS 80,640 ACRES, 126 SQUARE MILES**

The run volume has increased from 494 calls per year in 2007 to 790 calls in 2017, a 62% increase.

In 2017, 61% (484) of total calls dispatched by KITTCOM were for Emergency Medical Services.

Since the implementation of the SAFER Grant and the hiring of 9 career firefighters, our department has successfully responded to 100% of our run volume (when compared to 2017 where 29 incidents resulted in no response due to lack of availability).

The average turnout time (length of time from dispatch to enroute): 2 minutes, 48 seconds. (24/7 Staffed Station 73 from May 1, 2018 to September 1, 2018. Factors affecting turnout time may include gear change for call type such as EMS, structure fire, wildland fire). Firefighters are often enroute in less than 2 minutes.
