Adult Isolated Head Injury Pathway for Trauma Patients (excludes spines)

Worcestershire Royal and Alexandra Hospitals

Patients that have:

- Symptoms of an obvious head injury, or
- A CT scan demonstrating clear need for neurosurgical intervention, or
- Stage 1 or 2 triggers on the tool, but stopped-off at the TU for airway support

If immediate transfer to the MTC is required, this should be organised via the Regional Trauma Desk as the calls are recorded.

If no immediate transfer is required, please commence a NORSe Referral

For all other intracranial abnormalities

- 1. Contact Neurosurgical Team at University Hospitals Coventry & Warwick (MTC). If neurosurgical registrar is not available in a timely manner contact a consultant directly
- 2. Refer patient on "Refer a Patient" system

Further Information

Where the patient needs transferring out of the TU the Regional Trauma Desk will try to arrange a MERIT team to collect the patient. If this is not timely / feasible the TU will provide an anaesthetic escort.

If a patient needs their airway securing they should be transferred out ASAP and a scan should not slow things down. If not, it will often be a reasonable approach to scan the patient in the TU to further assess the extent of injury. This may be more difficult at night.
