The meetings begin at 10 AM with a brief business meeting followed by a program and guest speaker. No fee is required to attend and non-members are welcome. The November meeting is held jointly with the Cape Cod Genealogical Society on Cape Cod.

## Help Sessions

Every Tuesday from 2 to 4 PM at the Main Falmouth Public Library, members of Falmouth Genealogical Society assist anyone with their genealogical research. This is a free drop-in session with no appointment needed. An extensive collection of genealogical materials covering the globe is also available in the Lemke Reference Room.

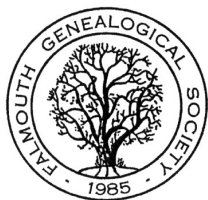
