Public comment

Several items were tabled including Approval of \$50,000 for Family Focus for a welcoming center, Recognizing the Public Benefit of the City Paying Private Sewer Repair Costs in Excess of \$15,000 (yes this is still an ongoing discussion and it was tabled because Kelly has invited two speakers from Chicago to explain their process and it was a holiday in the city), and two discussion items that were tabled due to time.

There was a lengthy presentation from a LEAP representative. Kelly wanted to table this as well. Then Burns explained it should not have been on the agenda because this program passed out of Human Services. They still discussed it and almost tabled it until Director Stonebeck said it should not be voted on because it should not have been on this agenda. I believe it passed at City Council.
