With the activities of our PC-to-Voter engagement contest in full swing our content will be focused on some great advice on Grassroots Action in your Local Precinct-providing you with insights and content to help in your conversations with neighbors.

Arizona Free Enterprise Club

Our first speaker will be Darla Gonzalez, the Grassroots Director for The Arizona Free Enterprise Club (AFEC). The AFEC strives to be a leader and ally for taxpayers and businesses, and their members play a key role in this effort. Among the efforts underway at the AFEC include petitions against vaccine mandates, Critical Race Theory, NO on HR4, Voter ID initiatives, and demanding that the Arizona Attorney General enforce the law. Darla has worked in Grassroots for the last 25 years. This experience includes the political arena (both profit and non-profit) in Oregon and Arizona. Her experience and content can arm you to engage with voters as part of our ongoing PC Contest!

Republican National Committee

Drew Sexton joins us to introduce us more deeply to the tools and experience that the Republican National Committee (RNC) bring to the Maricopa County LD Grass Roots Activists. Those of you experienced with Republican politics (and new PCs who have studied the LD23 PC Handbook (Pages 10-11)), will see that the RNC is at the top of the organizational structure which structurally consists of the Arizona Republican Committee (AZGOP), the County Committee (MCRC), and ultimately, the LD23 Committee to support our Grassroots. This structure supports you as PCs and Grassroots activists. The RNC is a resource- and experience-rich resource. We need to work together end-to-end to beat the Democrats, and we can learn a lot from Drew's experience and resources.

Drew Sexton serves as a Regional Political Director for the Republican National Committee, overseeing political operations in Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Oklahoma and Kansas. He most recently worked as the Arizona State Director for Trump Victory in 2020, overseeing more than 80 field staff, 20 Victory offices and orchestrating more than 8 million voter contacts during the cycle. Drew has been published and quoted in numerous local and national media outlets, as well as receiving a Pollie Award from the American Association of Political Consultants for direct mail work. Drew is a graduate of ASU with a B.A. in Political Science and Economics.

Drew is going to walk us through some of the resources that the RNC brings to us as PCs. A few examples of these resources you most recently have benefitted from include the GOP Data Center, Campaign Sidekick (indirectly) and other resources. Drew's role at the RNC influences funding for programs, facilities, and campaigns and implements these activities through our Committee structure. Drew has been a friend and advocate for LD23, and what I call the "Grassroots Shaman" supporting in about every aspect of voter contact, engagement, and analysis. Drew would also like to share some specifics from the 2020 Campaign on LD23's canvassing and turnout rates so we can learn more about canvassing and voter contact.
