

## TRAFFIC

87% of all visits are by car particularly to Honey pot sites like Castleton, Dove Dale and Chatsworth

Causes traffic congestion which impacts on locals increased pollution (air) and noise

## FOOTPATH EROSION

Heavy footfall in Honey pot areas and Pennine way destroys vegetation and compacts the soil.

This leads to gully erosion by rain water and paths widen.

+ Cycle damage to tracks and bridle ways

+ Off Road Vehicles increasing = damage to trackways
