1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:32 PM by Jim Dolloff.

2. Review/ Approve minutes

New Business

Animal refuge league discussion vs.. harvest hills shelter (see draft contract and pricing and email from Brandon) Selectmen discusses. ACO has communicated that there has been friction with Harvest Hills.

He has a good relationship with the ARL. ARL cost is \$2180.76, Harvest Hills cost is \$1525. Will put it to vote at town meeting.

Old Business

- Compensation for EMA officer Owen Sprague Owen spoke about compensation. Most EMA officers get paid a stipend. He estimates an average of 8 to 10 hours per month. Selectmen discussed and will put in \$1500 per year for EMA in town meeting warrant for next year.
- Selectmen reviewed and signed scholarship letters for 5 recipients.
