Attendance: Selectmen: Jim Dolloff and Dwight Warren, as well as members of the Public.

- Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:32 PM by Jim Dolloff.**
- Review/ Approve minutes**
Jim Dolloff requested a motion to accept and approve December 15th, 2020 minutes. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; no discussion. Selectmen voted 2-0 to approve the minutes.
- Review/ Approve warrant**
Jim Dolloff requested a motion to accept and approve December 29th, 2020 warrant. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; no discussion. Selectmen voted 2-0 to approve the warrant.

New Business

- **Animal refuge league discussion vs.. harvest hills shelter (see draft contract and pricing and email from Brandon)**
Selectmen discusses. ACO has communicated that there has been friction with Harvest Hills. He has a good relationship with the ARL. ARL cost is \$2180.76, Harvest Hills cost is \$1525. Will put it to vote at town meeting.

Selectmen will meet with Carl Landry, Monday January 4th @ 7PM to discuss school budget.

Old Business

- **Compensation for EMA officer Owen Sprague** - Owen spoke about compensation. Most EMA officers get paid a stipend. He estimates an average of 8 to 10 hours per month. Selectmen discussed and will put in \$1500 per year for EMA in town meeting warrant for next year.
- **Selectmen reviewed and signed scholarship letters for 5 recipients.**


