

Building for the future at Gov. Dodge



Visitors at Governor Dodge State Park will notice some changes at a popular trailhead at the north end of the park. Right across from the old barn is a new facility made possible through the combined efforts of park staff and the Friends of Governor Dodge State Park with help from Rule Construction of Dodgeville. Hikers, rock climbers and equestrians that frequent the area welcome the new comfort stop and find that they extend their time at the park as a result of the new amenities. In addition to a new vault toilet, drinking fountain, and kiosk, there is a new parking area and an inviting picnic spot. The project was funded in part by grants from the DNR Knowles Nelson Stewardship Program and Wisconsin Horse Council Trails Committee. Building for the Future, the vault toilet will also serve the future equestrian campground that will be located nearby.
