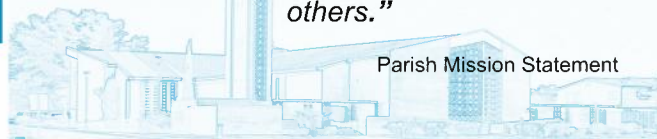

Baptisms—Baptismal arrangements must be made by the PARENTS of the child at the Parish Office. Parents and godparents *must* attend a baptismal preparation class before the baptism. Other requirements will be discussed at the initial interview.

Matrimony—Weddings are celebrated throughout the year. In accord with Church Law, at least one of the parties to be married must be a member of St. Joseph, otherwise special permissions are needed. Marriage preparation is to begin at least 6 months prior to the wedding. It is strongly recommended that a couple planning to be married at St. Joseph contact the Parish before making any contractual arrangements with a facility for their reception. During the initial interview with the priest of the Parish, the couple will be provided with all the necessary information needed for their preparation experience.

Job Title: Groundskeeper          Exemption Status: Non-exempt  
Department/Location St. Joseph Roman Catholic Parish - Tucson

Primary Function: Under the direction of the Pastor, Business Manager, School Principal or other assigned manager, is responsible for performing a variety of grounds keeping duties including light custodial duties

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Perform in support of the Parish and the Church's spiritual and pastoral mission

Perform general parish and school grounds keeping and custodial duties to include cleaning of Church or school grounds

Maintain parish and school grounds keeping and custodial equipment in a functional condition; recommend and oversee replacement of equipment as necessary

Keep grounds neatly manicured to include keeping lawns and shrubbery in a presentable condition

Maintain records of grounds maintenance performed as necessary

Maintain supply of cleaning equipment and supplies; maintain an inventory of all equipment and supplies; account for all inventory and equipment

Comply with chemical handling laws and safety regulations as required

Maintain a safe working environment

Maintain security of buildings, equipment, and tools

Perform other duties as assigned

Ability to successfully pass a background, criminal history, and credit history check

Physical/Mental Requirements: Requires coordination and manual dexterity, normal mental and visual ability; ability to lift a minimum of 45 lbs. as required in a normal grounds keeping and custodial environment.

Required Activities: Walking, sitting standing, stooping, reaching, talking, handling, hearing, carrying, climbing ladders.

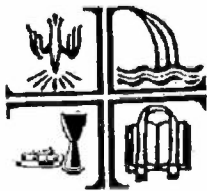
Teachers will present two times so that families with multiple students can listen to at least two presentations to learn about classroom/school procedures and expectations.
