Know The Snow Stuff

Well Winter has officially arrived! It is now time to focus on Snow removal. Per City ordinance 50.07 all side walks need to be cleared of snow or ice to the full width of the side walk within 24 hours after the same shall have fallen.

Please remember shoveling a path down the middle of the side walk does not meet the requirements of the ordinance.

A big safety concern is the snow and ice on the sidewalk that crosses the bottom of the driveway. The more it is driven on, the harder it is to clear. It is recommended that the side walk is cleared before crossing over it with a vehicle.

Please do not shovel the snow and ice into the street it is against City ordinance 50.05 to deposit anything in the road way.

A Spool of Blue Thread

"It was a beautiful, breezy, yellow-and-green afternoon. . . ." This is how Abby Whitshank always describes the day she fell in love with Red in July 1959. The Whitshanks are one of those families that radiate an indefinable kind of specialness, but like all families, their stories reveal only part of the picture: Abby and Red and their four grown children have accumulated not only tender moments, laughter, and celebrations, but also jealousies, disappointments, and carefully guarded secrets.
