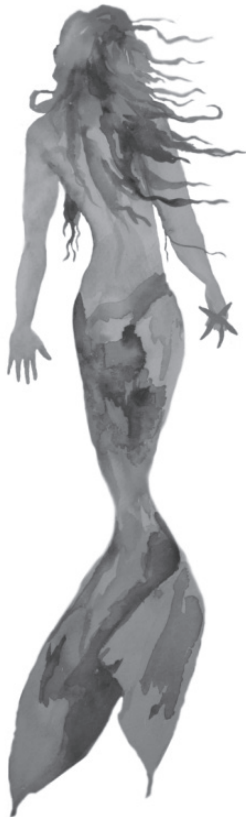

### FEATURED EXHIBITION: *Beach Finds of the Chesapeake*

The Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum will be exhibiting *Beach Finds of the Chesapeake* from April 6–June 29, 2019, in the Van Lennep Auditorium in the Steamboat Building. This exhibit explores a sampling of the different types of finds discovered by those who seek to preserve the history of the region by collecting fragments of its past. From shark teeth and other 20-million-year-old Miocene-era fossils, through Victorian doll parts and marbles, to modern plastic toys and marine debris found today, the Chesapeake Bay holds history, treasures and trash alike to be discovered by beachcombers who search its disappearing shorelines

He recently published *The Lure of Sea Glass, Our Connection to Nature's Gems*.

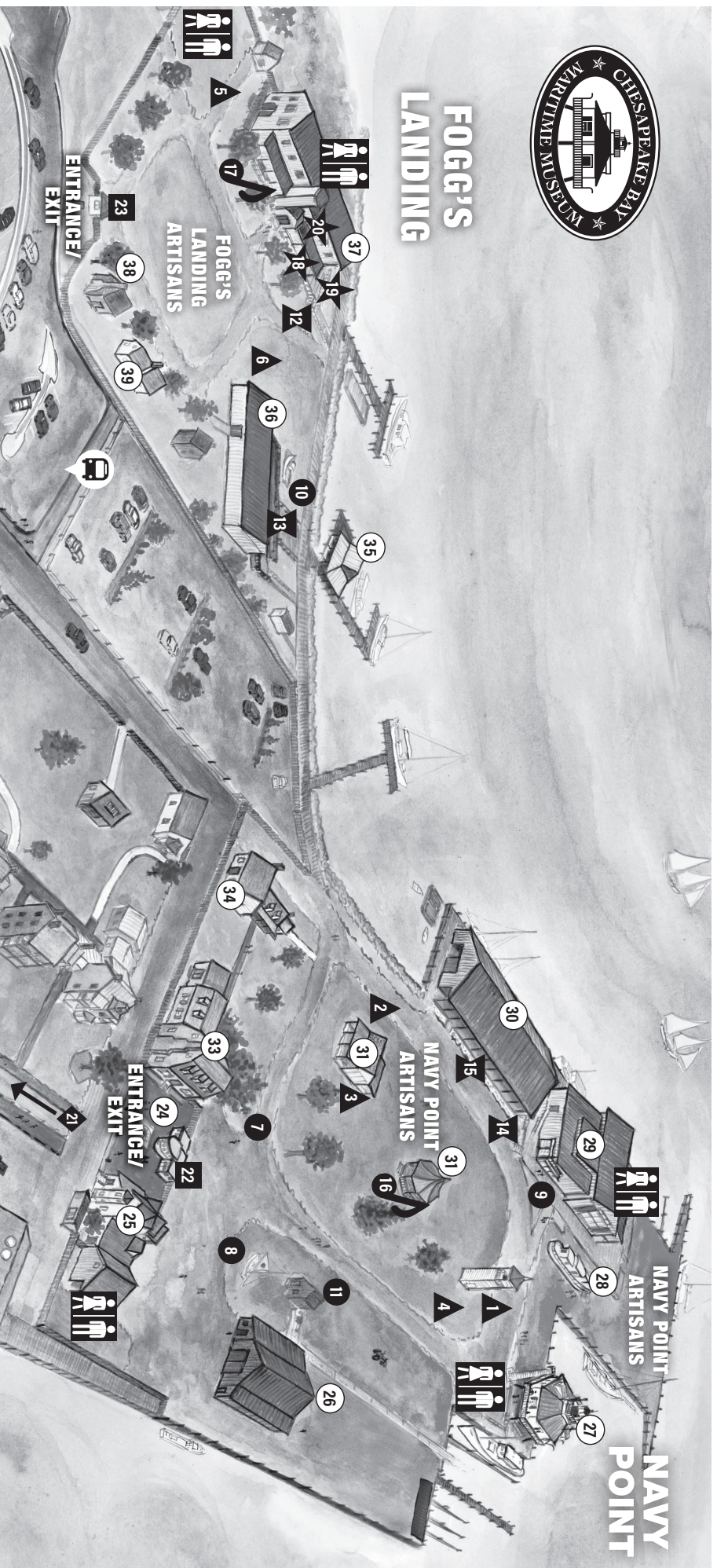
