ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY #5

A ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND SPENDING AGENCIES, IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSE AS SET FORTH BELOW, FOR THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, FOR THE 1992 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 2, 1991, and:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget, and;

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, so as not to impair the operations of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO;


Section 1. That the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for purposes stated:
