


El Santuario de los Pobladores

Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. Gravel has been spread in front and around the east and west sides of the labyrinth. Trees (6) have been planted. As donations are received, more trees will be placed. We have also planted shrubs and flower bushes and surrounded the area with gravel. Adobe dedication plaques are now in place in the labyrinth courtyard and placement of plaques continue. Once all these are in place, merchants who have supported our project, will also be acknowledged. Each outlying mission will have its own mission statue displayed when funds are available. Please support the volunteers seeking contributions from your placita. Your continued patience & cooperation is greatly appreciated as we work with volunteers in this phase of our project. St. Augustine & Holy Family statues are now in place at the Santuario. In addition, statues of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego will be placed at the entrance and donations are being accepted to begin this phase. Placement of new trees will also be available to contributors interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. Theme: Death and Life.

Great people were often controversial figures during their lifetime. It is history, which can look on from a distance and see things in proper perspective, that rectifies the often limited judgment of contemporaries. Something like this has happened to the Lord Jesus. His contemporaries, even his closest coworkers, did not understand him, especially not his strange ideas on suffering and death as a necessary passage to a better life.

Only later did all of this become clear to them. Today Christians celebrate Palm Sunday. "For it was to accomplish this mystery [his Passion and Resurrection] that he entered his own city of Jerusalem" (Procession Rite). The triumphal entry, celebrated at the beginning of the passion-week, emphasizes that the three elements: suffering, death, and resurrection, belong together. Jesus' death was not a defeat. It was a victory. "It is the genuine insight of Christianity that the events of Jesus' earthly life were the execution of God's saving purpose. This genuine insight should be ours also concerning our own lives when suffering strikes Us.

FIRST READING Is 50:4-7

[Christ's Suffering]

This reading is taken from the third song of the Servant of Yahweh. As mentioned at the feast of the Baptism of our Lord, it is not clear whom the inspired writer had in mind

when he composed these four songs describing the ideal Servant (Son) of God. Is he a collective person: Israel, God's people? Is he a king of the past or the Messiah (anointed king) to come? In any case, the Christian community applied these hymns very early to Jesus and they are used throughout Holy Week as a beautiful commentary on the passion narratives. Indeed, "the Son of Man [Jesus] did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Mt 20:28).

SECOND READING Phil 2:6-11

[Humility]

This text is actually a Christ hymn, sung in church. It beautifully describes our Lord's utmost humiliation, which he suffered on the cross. By being obedient, he made up for our sinful disobedience. But this hymn sings also of Christ's exaltation by the Father.

Meditating on the Lord's suffering and death, as Christians do during Holy Week, we should keep both sides of the Christ event in mind. It is suffering and death that actually constitutes a passage to exaltation. Good Friday and Easter belong together even in our lives!


