WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

The Montgomery County Council of Parent-Teacher Associations, Inc., (MCCPTA), an association of local PTAs and PTSAs in Montgomery County Maryland, is chartered by the Free State PTA. Its goals, in addition to the mission and purposes of PTA, are:

- To grow membership and parent involvement in PTA and our schools, to include and embrace all members of our Montgomery County Public School community;
- To engage parents, staff, and students in meaningful contributions that reflect their unique strengths for the benefit of students and school communities;
- To rally this engaged, growing membership in coordinated advocacy on issues of common concern.

Founded in 1944, MCCPTA has grown from 15 PTAs to 190+. This growth reflects the vital role PTA has had - individually and collectively through the council - in advocating for and meeting the needs of our children, our families, and our schools.

MCCPTA uses its collective strength on a wide range of issues, from budget advocacy to programs that foster creativity and a love of the arts in our children. MCCPTA works closely with MCPS to provide parent perspectives and input in budget discussion, on task forces, and in study groups, and to help disseminate information about school system events, developments, and changes in school system and Board of Education policy. MCCPTA also collaborates with the County Council, other County agencies, and members of the Montgomery County Delegation to the Maryland General Assembly on matters that affect children and youth, keeping these officials apprised on the issues of concern and interest to parents of county students.

WHAT PAYS FOR IT ALL

MCCPTA membership dues! MCCPTA dues—\$1.00 per member—are payable to MCCPTA monthly. **Checks should be made payable to MCCPTA and sent to the MCCPTA post office box.** MCCPTA does not mail invoices; a Google form is available on our website to fill out. It is recommended that checks be sent concurrently to Free State PTA and MCCPTA to help keep membership records straight.

State and National dues--\$2.00 Free State PTA and \$2.25 National PTA for a combined total of \$4.25 per member--are payable to Free State PTA and should be mailed to the Free State PTA office monthly. A quarterly invoice is mailed to each PTA from Free State PTA. State and National dues must be combined and paid by check made out to the Free State PTA and sent to the address below.
