**Hillsborough Holds a Doggie Reunion to Celebrate New Beginnings**

Last fall, Hillsborough County animal control officers rescued hundreds of dogs being kept in deplorable conditions by a local breeder. More than 300 of the Diana Street Dogs, as they came to be known, found new homes on Nov. 17, 2019 in a mass adoption event that was so popular tickets were distributed through a lottery system.

A year later, some of those dogs will reunite for the first time at the Hillsborough County Pet Resource Center, 440 N. Falkenburg Road.

More than a dozen dogs and their owners will gather in small playgroups at the Pet Resource Center at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 17 to take pictures, make new memories, and celebrate the dramatic changes in the dogs' lives. To maintain social distancing, the owners and their dogs will meet each other in several outdoor fenced play areas.

**Help Get These Dogs and Cats Home Before the Holidays**

With only a few weeks left in 2020, Hillsborough County's Pet Resource Center would like to see the shelter empty over the holidays. As part of the Home Before the Holidays promotion, PRC officials are encouraging residents to adopt or foster these dogs and cats to help end 2020 in the best possible way.

The Foster Express program can be a wonderful way for pets to get a much-needed break from life in the shelter. It relieves stress, provides the PRC staff with in-home observations that can make a dog or cat more adoptable, and potentially helps find them a forever home. Anyone can foster a dog or cat for a week or up to two months – just long enough to welcome a foster pet in to help ring in the holidays. You can find photos and other information about all available pets at HCFLGov.net/ADOPT. Once you find a foster friend, submit a request at HCFLGov.net/AtYourService.

The Pet Resource Center, 440 N. Falkenburg Road in Tampa, is also a popular place for adoptions. All adoption fees are currently waived, and residents need only make an appointment to meet their future furry best friend at the shelter. All pets are registered, vaccinated, and spayed or neutered prior to adoption. Appointments can be made online or by calling (813) 744-5660. Appointments are available from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, and other times if available.

The Pet Resource Center is also offering curbside pick-up and delivery of adoptions via the Curbside Cuddle Program.

The Pet Resource Center also has a working cats program that features cats that might not be appropriate for an indoor environment but are ideal around barns, warehouses, and homes on large properties.

**Beware of COVID-19 Texting Scam**

Attorney General Ashley Moody is warning taxpayers of a new COVID-19 related text scam that deceives recipients into disclosing personal banking information in order to receive a \$1,200 stimulus check. This latest scam impersonates the Internal Revenue Service. The Attorney General's Office reminds taxpayers that the federal government and state agencies will never require personal banking information to be disclosed via text message to receive stimulus payments.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said, "As long as COVID-19 remains a threat, scammers will attempt every trick in the book to exploit taxpayers and coerce them into disclosing personal information. I encourage all Floridians to familiarize themselves with emerging COVID-19 scams, available on our COVID-19 resource webpage at MyFloridaLegal.com/COVID19."

The scam text message states the recipient received a \$1,200 direct deposit from COVID-19 TREAS FUND and requires further action for the payment to be deposited into the account. The text then directs the recipient to follow a fake phishing link.

The bogus phishing URL appears to be a state agency or relief organization's website. However, when clicked, the URL directs recipients to a website fraudulently impersonating the IRS. Scammers use the website with the goal of collecting the personal and financial information of individuals who visit the fraudulent site.

Those who receive this text should immediately report it to the IRS by sending a screenshot of the message to Phishing@IRS.gov with the following information:

- Date, time and time zone the text message was received;
- The 10-digit phone number that sent the text; and
- The recipient's mobile phone number.

The Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division reminds taxpayers that the IRS will never send unsolicited texts or emails requesting personal information, call with threats of jail, lawsuits or demand tax payments on gift cards. If you receive any correspondence you believe to be fraudulent, report it to the Attorney General's Office by visiting MyFloridaLegal.com, calling 1(866) 9NO-SCAM or downloading the No Scam app, available in English and Spanish, on all Apple and Android devices.

If you believe you are eligible for the Economic Impact Payment, please visit IRS.gov. If you do not have a filing requirement but are eligible for EIP, use the non-filers tool on the IRS website before Nov. 21 to claim the payment.



An attitude of gratitude is always obvious. If we are grateful for what God has done for us and given to us, others will see our appreciation of it in everything we do. David gave us a fourfold formula to follow.

"I will thank You Lord, with all my heart." The *thanksgiving* he describes is total and consumes all of his being - his entire self. The word he used for *heart* would include his consciousness of God's presence, his memory of God's goodness and his awareness of God's grace. He worshiped God with excitement, enthusiasm and expectation.

"I will tell all of the marvelous things You have done." Marvelous comes from a word that means "extraordinary, not to be surpassed by anyone and wonderful!" He is so overwhelmed by God's blessings on his life that he wants everyone to hear about it.

"I will be filled with joy!" Joy is the natural state of the one who trusts in the Lord. Knowing that "all things work together for our good" should cause His joy to radiate from our hearts into our heads and out through our hands. Everything we do should be done with a smile on our face and gladness in our eyes.

"I will sing praises to Your Name, O Most High." Notice that there is only one letter different between the word "sin" and "sing" - the letter "g" - that stands for God. When we give up sin for the Savior, God gives us a new song to sing. It is a song about the Savior who loves us, gave Himself for us, is present in us and cares for us.



**Nov. 16 County Commission COVID-19 Summary: Resolution Advocates for Routine Staff Testing at Senior Care Facilities, Other Congregate Homes**

COVID-19 coronavirus Update No. 239

Hillsborough County Commissioners today unanimously approved a resolution which recommends routine COVID-19 coronavirus testing of staff at nursing homes, assisted living facilities, intermediate care facilities, group homes, and homes for persons with disabilities.

Changes in state and federal guidelines have created some gaps in staff testing in these congregate, close-contact settings, where both workers and residents are vulnerable for contracting and spreading COVID-19. In Hillsborough County, there are nearly 300 nursing homes and assisted living facilities, and approximately 160 group homes. In addition to recommending that these facilities routinely test employees, the resolution recommends that the State of Florida consider instituting statewide rules for such testing.

The action came as the number of local COVID-19 cases has been steadily increasing over the past few weeks. This trend is happening across the country, said Dr. Douglas Holt, director of the Florida Department of Health in Hillsborough County.

Hillsborough County COVID-19 statistics include:

The rolling 7-day average of cases was 302 on Nov. 14, compared to 253 on Nov. 2.

The rolling 14-day daily positive rate was 8.28% on Nov. 8, compared to 6.08% on Oct. 18.

The highest number of cases continues to be in the 20-29 age group, followed by the 30-39 and 40-49 age groups.

With the holidays coming up, Dr. Holt reminded residents of the importance of continuing to take COVID-19 precautions. Wear face coverings when around others in public. Practice social distancing. Wash hands, use hand sanitizer, and don't touch your face. Limit gatherings to no more than 10 people. He also recommended that college students be tested for COVID-19 before returning home to spend time with family and friends.

In other action today, Commissioners: Approved an agreement with Catholic Charities Diocese of St. Petersburg, Inc. to acquire and renovate a 20-unit motel in Ruskin for housing for residents who have been displaced because of COVID-19. The units will be set aside for households at or below 80% of area median income. The agreement is being funded by \$1.25 million from the Coronavirus Relief Fund program.

Extended the state of local emergency enacted in response to the COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic. The extension is in effect at least through Nov. 26. A state of local emergency can be in effect for only seven days, unless extended. The emergency declaration gives the County Administrator and emergency managers the ability to quickly take certain actions to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and provides a path for federal reimbursement of certain expenses.

Commissioners will discuss the state of local emergency and other COVID-19 issues at their next regular meeting on Wednesday, Dec. 2.

**Face Coverings Mandate Remains in Effect**

**Northlakes Sports Complex to Get a Lot Greener**

Northlakes Sports Complex is getting a major landscaping upgrade, courtesy of the Greater Tampa Association of Realtors and Hillsborough County Parks & Recreation.

On Wednesday, Nov. 18, volunteers from the Realtors association will beautify the park at 2640 N. Lakeview Drive in Tampa by planting about 40 live oaks, robellini palms, purple tabebuias, crepe myrtles, bald cypress and red maple trees, along with 20 blueberry flax lilies. Volunteers also will deep-clean the park's concession stand and do other landscaping.

A portion of the project is funded through a Community Rebuilding Grant from the National Association of Realtors; funds for the trees come through Hillsborough County's Tree Fund.

The benefits of trees are more than just aesthetic. Trees improve air quality, lessen stormwater runoff, harbor wildlife, and reduce the heat island effect in cities. Green spaces also can help lower the level of crime within urban environments.

Hillsborough County's popular Northlakes Sports Complex includes baseball, soccer, and lacrosse fields, basketball, pickleball, tennis, and racquetball courts, along with playgrounds and walking trails. It is owned and operated by Hillsborough County Parks & Recreation.

Peanut butter is so popular in the United States that we spent 2.3 billion dollars on it in 2019 ([www.statista.com](http://www.statista.com)).

If you were to look at the nutrition fact label, you would see that creamy peanut butter has 190 calories for only two tablespoons. This is a high-calorie food item. It also has a total of 16 grams of fat, mostly from saturated fat and 3 grams of sugar with 2 grams of added sugar. So, on the surface, this could look like something you would want to steer away from in your diet.

Peanut butter does have some health benefits. Looking at the same nutrition fact label, you will find that peanut butter has 7 grams of protein, B Vitamins, fiber, Vitamin E, and potassium. Let's compare the potassium and sodium ratio; salted peanut butter has about twice as much potassium as sodium, and even though the best ratio would be 1:3, this still compares quite favorably with bologna, roast beef, and other sandwich fixings. There is scientific evidence suggesting that eating 1.5 ounces of nuts or nut products per day is heart-healthy and can lower cholesterol and blood sugar levels. However, this has not been proven.

Peanut butter is an inexpensive, nutrient-dense food used in times of struggle. It is on the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) approved list because it provides protein for children that promotes muscle growth and maintenance. It is also in food pantries and is one of the most sought-after items because it is packed full of nutrients, can last a long time, and can be purchased with SNAP benefits.

Now that we know how important this food can be for families, I would like to mention that UF/IFAS Hillsborough County Extension office is collecting peanut butter for our local food pantries. Please drop off a jar or two at our office: 5339 CR 579 Seffner, FL 33584. Or you can collect some at your office, church, or school and bring by a bunch to share.

**Peanut butter & honey muffins**

- author: pinch of yum
- prep time: 15 mins
- cook time: 12 mins
- total time: 27 minutes
- yield: 6

**DESCRIPTION**  
*These peanut butter and honey muffins are easy to make and so delicious for breakfast or a snack. Fluffy, light, and perfect peanut butter honey flavor!*

- INGREDIENTS**
- 1 cup flour
  - 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
  - pinch of salt
  - 3 tablespoons peanut butter (crunchy or smooth)
  - 2 tablespoons oil
  - 3 tablespoons honey (agave nectar if vegan)
  - 3/4 cup milk (almond, soy, etc. if vegan)

- INSTRUCTIONS**
1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Whisk the flour, baking powder, and salt.
  2. Add the peanut butter and oil and mix with a fork until crumbs form.
  3. Add the milk and honey and mix until just combined. Do not beat.
  4. Pour into muffin tins (about 3/4 full) and bake for 10-12 minutes, until tops are golden brown and spring back when you touch them.

## Dumped Chemicals, Construction Debris, Tires, Other Trash Spur Interagency Assault

Hillsborough County Code Enforcement, Solid Waste officials work with deputies to combat large-scale illegal dumping



A coordinated effort led to the arrest of the "Tire Bandit," who dumped old tires in Hillsborough and Pinellas counties.

Illegal dumping takes place throughout Hillsborough County. Sometimes it is so extensive, or potentially dangerous, that Hillsborough County Code Enforcement and Solid Waste departments partner with law enforcement and the county's Environmental Protection Commission to rectify the problem.

A few times each month the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office's Environmental Enforcement Unit responds to reports of excessive dumping. The refuse might be oil or chemicals that harm the environment, debris that poses a hazard on roadways, or discarded tires that fill with rainwater to make ideal breeding grounds for mosquitoes. Construction materials, dead animals, and household items such as furniture and appliances also present problems.

Dead-end roads, dark rural trails, and vacant properties are frequent dump sites.

Deputies and Code Enforcement officers investigate complaints of large-scale dumping, and Code Enforcement cleans up the messes. The Sheriff's Environmental Enforcement Unit can cite or file criminal charges against those responsible. Code Enforcement issues civil citations. The goals are to remove potential hazards, to recover the cost of the investigation, cleanup, and any court expenses, and to discourage more dumping.

The various agencies routinely communicate by telephone and email. Among their successes: Bringing down the "Tire Bandit" who dumped more than 3,400 worn-out vehicle tires at 10 or more obscure sites in Hillsborough and Pinellas counties. With relentless pressure that included felony warrants, the partners cleared a score of cases and ultimately put the Tire Bandit out of business.

"We all count on each other," says Master Deputy Anthony Osborne, who heads the Hillsborough Sheriff's Environmental Enforcement Unit.

Illegal dumping not only threatens the environment and public safety, it can lower area property values. An unsightly mess sometimes degrades a neighborhood's appeal to the point that other types of crime increase.

If you see illegal dumping in your neighborhood, especially on a large scale, contact Hillsborough County Code Enforcement. Meanwhile, know how to dispose of your own unwanted trash and recyclable materials.

Total time: 1 hour  
Servings: 12

### Cranberry Walnut Ginger Compote:

- 1/2 cup California Walnuts
- 2 cups cranberries
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1/2 cup maple syrup
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1 orange, zest only

### Overnight Walnut French Toast:

- 8 slices Texas Toast or 1-inch thick slices French bread
- 1/4 cup butter, melted, plus additional for baking dish, divided
- 2 1/2 cups milk or walnut milk
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 6 eggs

To make Cranberry Walnut Ginger Compote: Preheat oven to 350 F. Place walnuts on baking sheet and toast 8 minutes. Remove from heat and chop coarsely.

In medium pot over medium heat, combine toasted walnuts, cranberries, orange juice, syrup, ginger and orange zest. Bring to boil and stir frequently 12-15 minutes until cranberries pop and liquid starts to reduce.

Transfer to container and refrigerate once cooled.

To make Overnight Walnut French Toast: Preheat oven to 350 F.

Place bread on baking sheet and bake 5 minutes, or until lightly toasted on outside but still soft on inside. Butter 13-by-9-inch baking dish.

In large bowl, whisk milk, sugar, 1/4 cup butter, vanilla extract, cinnamon and eggs. Dip each bread slice in mixture and let soak about 15 seconds on each side. Place in prepared baking dish, overlapping slices slightly, if necessary.

Cover and refrigerate a few hours or overnight.

## Walnut Chocolate Peppermint Bundt Cake

Total time: 1 hour, 30 minutes  
Servings: 16

### Cake:

- 1 cup butter, plus additional for greasing pan, divided
- 1/2 cup unsweetened cocoa powder, plus additional for dusting pan, divided
- 1 cup water
- 2 1/4 cups sugar
- 1 teaspoon peppermint extract
- 3 eggs
- 2 cups flour
- 3/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 cup buttermilk
- 1 cup California Walnut halves and pieces

### Chocolate Peppermint Truffle Glaze:

- 1/3 cup dark chocolate chips
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract

### Toppings:

- 1/2 cup coarsely chopped California Walnuts
- 1/2 cup crushed peppermint candy

To make cake: Preheat oven to 350 F. Lightly butter bundt pan then dust with cocoa powder. Turn pan, tapping, to coat on all sides; tap out excess.

In small saucepan over low heat, melt 1 cup butter, 1/2 cup cocoa powder and water, whisking until smooth; let cool.

Transfer to bowl of mixer and lightly beat in sugar, peppermint extract and eggs.

In medium bowl, mix flour, baking powder, salt and baking soda. Add about 1/3 of dry ingredients to chocolate mixture and beat on low speed to combine. Add 1/4 cup buttermilk and beat again. Repeat steps ending with flour mixture, mixing only until combined. Fold in walnuts.

Spread in prepared pan and bake 50-60 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Let cool then invert onto serving plate or platter.

To make Chocolate Peppermint Truffle Glaze: While cake bakes, melt chocolate chips, butter, milk and peppermint extract together until smooth. Let cool slightly to thicken then drizzle over cake. Top with walnuts and peppermint candies.



Mosquitoes from Breeding**

Tropical Storm Eta's windblown and wa-  
ter-driven debris scattered across Hillsborough  
County, as well as floodwaters, means additional  
breeding grounds for mosquitoes. Any debris or  
other items that hold water - from a Styrofoam  
cup to a torn plastic tarp - can allow mosquitoes  
to breed by the thousands. It's important to drain  
this water and dispose of, cover, or move these  
items to prevent the spread of mosquitoes.

The easiest way to prevent mosquito  
bites is to stop them from breeding in the first  
place. Mosquito larvae need water to grow, so  
the most effective method to keep them from re-  
producing is to deprive them of water.

**Follow these tips:**

- Wear long-sleeved shirts, long pants, and in-  
sect repellent while you're out cleaning up your  
yard.
- Pick up and drain water from overturned gar-  
bage cans and flower pots, as well as pool cov-  
ers, coolers, toys, buckets, watering cans, kiddie  
pools, and any other containers where rainwater  
collected.
- Clean out rain gutters and downspouts, espe-  
cially those that are clogged with storm debris.
- Discard old tires, drums, bottles, cans, pots and  
pans, broken appliances, and other items that  
may collect water.
- Check and correct chlorination levels in pools  
which received more rainwater during Irma.
- Empty and clean birdbaths and pet water bowls.
