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# Radius/Indiana, Ivy Tech, StoneGate partner to present cyber security classes

Classes scheduled to begin in March

BEDFORD – Ivy Tech Community College has expanded its cyber security program and will now offer certification training at StoneGate Arts & Education Center, 931 15th St.

Starting in March, Ivy Tech cyber security training will be offered at StoneGate in multiple formats, including eight-week courses during the day, eight-week evening courses, and one-week bootcamps.

From March 8-12, Ivy Tech will offer its first week-long Cyber Security Bootcamp to prepare participants to earn their CompTIA Security+certification. Bootcamp classes will run from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. at StoneGate.

Individuals who complete the Bootcamp will be eligible to sit for the current CompTIA Security+ certification, which is an entry-level workforce credential for some cyber security positions.

Additionally, participants who successfully pass CompTIA Security+ can earn four Ivy Tech college credits to apply toward earning a credential.

"Through our partnership with Ivy Tech, we can be part of the solution to address critical cyber issues facing our community and region," StoneGate Executive Director Gene McCracken said. "Also, we would like to thank Radius Indiana for its generous contribution of new computers that will help equip our classroom."

Students who have not already earned a college degree, could be eligible to earn a tuition-free lvy Tech certification in cyber security, paid for by the Workforce Ready Grant through Next Level Jobs Indiana.

"Because we have a new cyber security training lab at StoneGate, Ivy Tech can now offer other cyber security training courses that lead to a college certification or associate degree," said Ivy Tech Community College Chancellor Jennie Vaughan.

"With enough demand, students will be able to complete a full associate degree in cyber security at StoneGate, downtown Bedford," Vaughan said.
