Prayer of the Day

Heavenly Father, thank You that Christ died for our sins, and rose again to give us His new, resurrected life so that in the power of the Spirit, we may love as He loved. May the love of Christ flow through us to others so that Christ's love is seen in us. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen

First Lesson Ruth 1:6-9, 14-18 **6** Then she arose with her daughters-in-law to return from the country of Moab, for she had heard in the fields of Moab that the Lord had visited his people and given them food.**7** So she set out from the place where she was with her two daughters-in-law, and they went on the way to return to the land of Judah.**8** But Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, "Go, return each of you to her mother's house. May the Lord deal kindly with you, as you have dealt with the dead and with me.**9** The Lord grant that you may find rest, each of you in the house of her husband!" Then she kissed them, and they lifted up their voices and wept.**14** Then they lifted up their voices and wept again. And Orpah kissed her mother-in-law, but Ruth clung to her.**15** And she said, "See, your sister-in-law has gone back to her people and to her gods; return after your sister-in-law."**16** But Ruth said, "Do not urge me to leave you or to return from following you. For where you go I will go, and where you lodge I will lodge. Your people shall be my people, and your God my God.**17** Where you die I will die, and there will I be buried. May the Lord do so to me and more also if anything but death parts me from you."**18** And when Naomi saw that she was determined to go with her, she said no more.

Second Lesson Colossians 3:12-17 **12** Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,**13** bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.**14** And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.**15** And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.**16** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.**17** And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Gospel John 19:23-27 **23** When the soldiers had crucified Jesus, they took his garments and divided them into four parts, one part for each soldier; also his tunic. But the tunic was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom,**24** so they said to one another, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it to see whose it shall be." This was to fulfill the Scripture which says, "They divided my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots." So the soldiers

did these things,[25](#) but standing by the cross of Jesus were his mother and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.[26](#) When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son!"[27](#) Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.

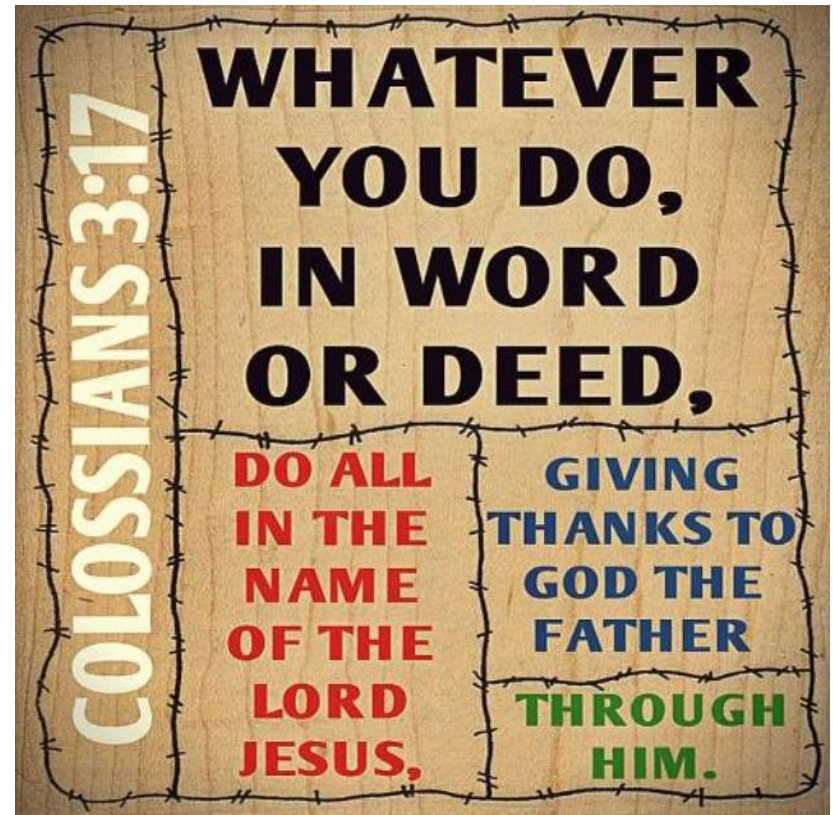
