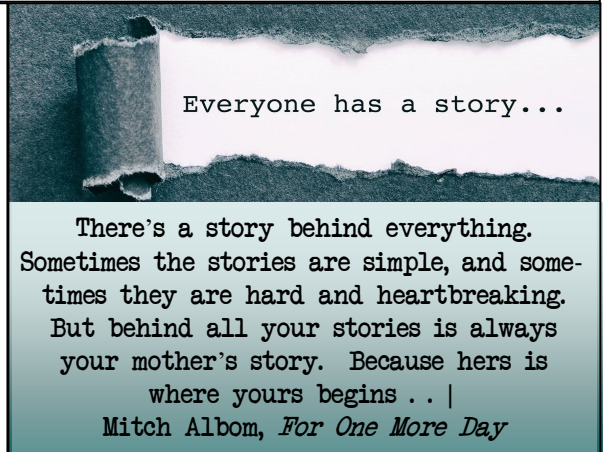
DID YOU KNOW?

- FACT: 48 million Americans have significant hearing loss.
- FACT: Over 90% of deaf children are born to hearing parents.
- FACT: 14% of those ages 45-64 have some type of hearing loss.
- FACT: 15% of children between the ages of 6-19 have a measurable hearing loss in at least one ear.
- FACT: One in every three people over the age of 65 – a total of 165 million people worldwide – live with hearing loss.
- FACT: People with hearing loss wait an average of seven years before seeking help.
- FACT: Noise is the leading cause of hearing Loss.
- FACT: Untreated hearing loss increases the risk for dementia.
- FACT: Only one out of every five people who could benefit from a hearing aid wear one

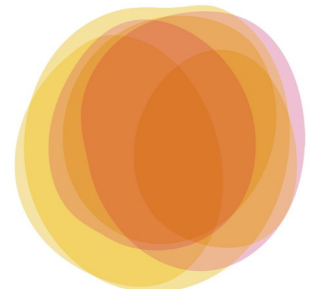
