On Saturday we will have a guided tour and an included colonial tavern lunch at the King's Arm's followed by time on our own to explore more of the history and shops. Our weekend also includes a visit with a Nation Builder. Nation Builders portray real historic figures associated with 18th-century Williamsburg who made significant contributions to the American story. On Sunday we will visit Busch Gardens, the world's most beautiful theme park, which has been transformed into "Christmas Town" for the season. With over 10-million lights, this is one of the largest Christmas light displays in North America. We'll enjoy festive food and drink, holiday shopping and heart-warming shows that make the spirit of the season come alive. (4 Meals)
