Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Chandler at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call: Goodin, Chandler, Wiederhold, Missler and Curley were present.

Motion by Missler and supported by Curley to approve the agenda as written. Motion carried.

Motion by Curley and supported by Missler to approve the October 19th, 2020 regular meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report: Wiederhold

Received \$2,005.40 & \$2,016.33 from D&P Cable and \$105.51 from Buckeye Cable for franchise fees. Received \$58,156 from the State of Michigan for constitutional sales tax. Received \$2,000 from Stevens Disposal for site plan. No donations were received. I will be mailing 2020 winter tax bills the day after Thanksgiving. Trustee Missler inquired if the conditional land transfer money has been received from the City of Petersburg. Clerk Goodin advised that it hasn't, but will take care of it and present it to the board this week. Total amount in all accounts is \$2,031,208.54. Motion by Curley and supported by Goodin to accept Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Public Comment:

New Business:

Land division (Romero) – Motion by Wiederhold and supported by Curley to approve the lot split and combination for Manuel Romero at 16040 Toad Road based on the contingencies of the tax certification statement and mortgage release (clear title work) being met. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Appointment – Motion by Goodin and supported by Wiederhold to appoint Dan Curley to the Board of Review. Roll call vote: 4 yeas, 1 nay, 1 abstained (Curley). Motion carried.

Appointment – Motion by Missler and supported by Goodin to reappoint Linda Diesing to Zoning Board of Appeals. The term is three years and will expire 06/2023. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Appointment – PA 660 requires each county to notify the State Tax Commission of the individual that will serve as the county's Designated Assessor. Motion by Chandler and supported by Goodin to appoint Michael Woolford as our Designated Assessor. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.
