In the news this week:

- 1. Re-registration.** At the present time I am working to set tuition figures for the 2019-2020 school year. The re-registration material will be sent home the week of January 21<sup>st</sup>. Please read all material carefully and return the registration form with registration fee and student activity fee to the school by February 5<sup>th</sup>. Let me take this opportunity to thank you for sharing your children with us and choosing St. Anne School for their education.
- 2. Catholic Schools Week.** Our Catholic Schools Week celebration will take place the week of January 27, 2019. This year's theme is Catholic Schools: Learn. Serve. Lead. Succeed. At this time a schedule for the week's activities is being formulated and will be sent home as soon as it is available.

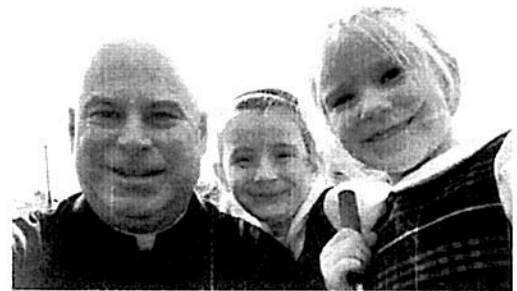
