As we continue to plan the summer's events, let me update you on some of the things that have happened here at the camp this past March.

For the past six years the camp has hosted the annual 10-K Swamp Run and 1-mile fun run. Each year there has been an average of at least 130 + runners. Many supporters also show up to cheer the runners on. There are about 300 people on the camp grounds that day. Always room for a Lion!

Although the camp had some severe thunderstorms earlier in the week, the grounds were in good shape. Maybe a few mud puddles as they ran through some of the trails over at the State Park.

This event has been a great support of helping many campers' attend camp. Funds raised usually equal up to about 10 camper sponsorships per year. Plan to attend next year if you can. The event

is always in March after Gate River Run held each year in Jacksonville, Fla. Did you know that the Gate River Run can have as many as 18,000 runners participate? What if we could have a thousand? We definitely would need your help to do this! It may even make the news.

Camp Finances Y-T-D thru MARCH 31, 2022

Financially, The GA Lions Camp finished the 1st quarter of 2022 a little behind the level of Income that was expected for the 1st 3 months of the year. *As you can see below,* we expected to have 68,990.00 in income after 3 months -- we only had 58,702.97. However, thanks to doing a good job of Expense Control by the Camp Staff, we under spent on expected expenses -- so we pretty well balanced the 1st Quarter. **Our challenge is now the 2nd Quarter**, because Camping season will be here as we complete the 2nd Quarter -- so **NOW is the time** we need everyone's help to increase our cash so we can make it thru the upcoming Camping Season Financially. APRIL has started off well, financially, but we really need to concentrate on Income from all sources for APRIL to end well, financially. Our Expenses are extremely heavy during Camping Season.

Please support the Camp any way you can, and as early, as you can -- and urge others in your Club to do the same. There are numerous ways to make your contribution -- and your Club will receive credit at the same time. Our Fundraising Committee is working hard to do their part, please support them in their effort.

The Budget needed will get a little harder to attain as each month leading up to Camping Season goes by. We did it in January, February -- we were a little low in March -- so Please help us make the Budget in April and May-- it will benefit the Camp in many ways.

Work Projects

The following projects will be updated monthly in our camp newsletter. If you see a project that you or your club would be interested in helping with, please email your interest to <u>director@glcb.org</u>

April 29-May 1, 2022 are our next scheduled Service Days:

(Please know that you can call and schedule a workday anytime the camp does not have an event going on)

(You don't have to wait until a scheduled Service Day to come work at the camp)

- 1. Buildings need pressure washing.
- 2. Weed pulling, edging, raking, wheel barrow use, and sanitation are many other jobs to be done during this work session. BRING your gloves and definitely some BUG SPRAY!!
- 3. Repair the Whale Watch element at the Low Ropes Course.
- 4. Climbing Wall due for pressure washing and wood treatment (Man lift will need to be rented to accomplish this task). Other minor maintenance can be done during this activity.
- 5. Clean Low Ropes area.
- 6. Repair screens at the bar-b-que shelter.
- 7. Wooden picnic tables need repairs or replacing. (Some work has been done, need more help) some painting needed.
- 8. Nature Trail clean up debris. To build up low lying areas we continue to need Two loads of crushed asphalt and Two loads of fill dirt.
- 9. Clean up fallen debris from trees around the camp.
- 10. Several dead pine trees need to be cut down and debris cleaned up.
- 11. Paint water heater room located behind the newly renovated Staff Building.
- 12. Paint the Water Tank.
- 13. Paint the new Lifeguard stands for the pool.
- 14. Stain and treat all wooden rockers and chairs.
- 15. Paint the pump house at the pond.
- 16. Fish Pond needs some fall cleanup.
- 17. Paint sidewalks at the exit doors to the bunkhouse.
- 18. Repair Emergency exit door at restrooms in the Dining Hall.
- 19. Clean and paint swing frames at the fire pit area.
- 20. Swings at the fire pit need to be cleaned and painted.
- 21. Activity Site Warning signs have been replaced and repaired but framing needs cleaning and painting.
- 22. Repaint Dining Hall.
- 23. Some Emergency Lights in Main Dorm needs to be replaced.

24. Lights in Large Dormitory and Bunkhouse Dormitory still need to be converted to LED bulbs.

*Remove carpet from (Rental House) (Director's house)

*(Rental House) Replace carpet with laminate flooring. Funding needed. *These two items will be completed when funds are available.
