During the course of their 17 game schedule our "B" team scored a total of 1062 points while holding their opponents to 717 points. This averages out to 62.5 points per game for Magdalena while holding their opponents average to 42.2 points per game, a truly fine indication of the defensive ability of this team. This group of boys was composed of mainly freshmen and sophomores which makes the future of basketball at Magdalena High School look very bright indeed.






