Arthur Marshall Johnson, 54, of Brunswick, Maine and formerly of Zephyrhills, Fla., died peacefully after a period of declining health on Thursday, Dec. 1, 2011 at Mid Coast Hospital.

Arthur was born Sept. 10, 1957 in Springfield, Mass., a son of the late Richard A. Johnson and Jane E. (Miller) Johnson of Brunswick, Maine.
