

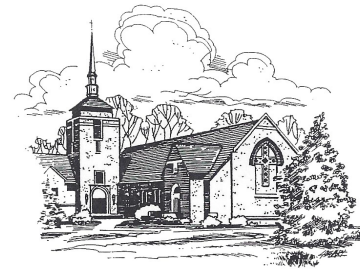

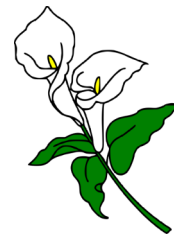
**\*GOSPEL READING**      *Matthew 22:34-40*

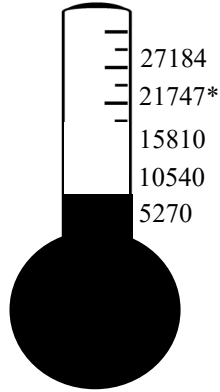
