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## PA Emergency Back-Up Registry (EBUPS)

The Public Authority currently operates and maintains a registry of providers who are looking to work for IHSS clients. Typically clients who request a list generally are not in need of urgent, immediate care, but for those who are, we also operate an emergency back - up registry. The emergency back-up registry is available for clients who have an urgent need or would be at risk of our of home placement with out a provider.

EBUPS is intended to be a temporary placement until the clients regular provider returns or a permanent provider is found.

Emergency providers will be given a pay increase of \$2 an hour while on the specific emergency assignment.

#### **Provider Requirements:**

- Must be listed as an eligible provider in the payroll system
- Must be listed on the IHSS PA Registry as active or fully employed
- Must not turn down 3 or more requested from PA within a year period
- Must be able to respond to client within a 2 hours time frame
- Must have an active cell phone account

### **IHSS Sick Leave**

This is a friendly reminder that any unused sick leave time that has been accrued will expire on 6/30/2025 and re-set on 7/1/2025. Providers must meet <u>eligibility</u> requirements to receive and use sick time. Sick leave can be claimed either on the ESP timesheet website or by filling out and returning a SOC 2302 form.
